Format

Tar Heel Cup consists of two days of competition. Day 1 format is Four-Ball Match Play. Day 2 format is Singles Match Play. Each match is worth 1 point each. A halved match earns each side ½ point. Since we are the defending champions, we need 6 points to retain the Cup, 6 ½ points to officially win. CPGA needs 6 ½ points to win.

Team Uniforms

CGA will provide each team member with two Adidas shirts, an Adidas pullover and two hats. Plan to wear khaki pants each day. You may pick-up your uniform in the River Landing clubhouse foyer beginning at 10:30am on Monday. Let's plan to take a team photo with Day 1 uniforms on at 11:00am outside the River Landing golf shop.

Daily Uniforms:

Monday: White shirt, Khaki pants, Blue hat.

Tuesday: Blue shirt, Khaki pants, White Hat.

Starting Times

Day 1 Four-Ball starting times begin at 12:00pm off #1 tee. Pairings will be announced about one week from the event. Day 2 singles starting times will run from 8:00am-8:56am off #1 tee. Day 2 matches and starting times will be announced at the Monday night dinner. Let me know if you have any four-ball partner preferences.

Practice Round and Course Fees

A complimentary practice round is available on Sunday, April 5 after 12:00pm for Tar Heel Cup participants. Call the River Landing golf shop to schedule a practice round. Make sure to identify yourself as a Tar Heel Cup participant. It would be helpful if you make your own game before calling. There are no course fees for the practice round or competition rounds.

Food and Beverage

A food and beverage tab will be available for Tar Heel Cup contestants at the bar in the clubhouse on April 6-7. Tell the attendant you are with the Tar Heel Cup Matches. Personal coolers are not allowed.

Monday Night Dinner

CGA and CPGA will host cocktails and dinner on Monday night at the cottages for both teams. Dress is golf casual (shorts are acceptable). Cocktails at 6:15pm with dinner at 7:00pm.

Lodging

Lodging for Monday, April 6 is paid by the CGA. You are on your own for any lodging expenses on April 5 or 7. Each team will have its own cottage at River Landing that is located adjacent to each other behind the 10th tee of the River Course. Each cottage has 4 bedrooms with 2 queen beds and a full bathroom in each room along with a center room with a full kitchen and living room. **Let me know if you have any roommate requests.**

We will not be able to check-in to the cottages until after the Monday four-ball matches and must checkout on Tuesday morning prior to the singles matches. We will let you know which cottage each team will be assigned to. Please use the clubhouse locker room to change clothes or shower prior to Monday's four-ball matches or following Tuesday's singles matches.

Live Scoring

To provide better course-wide understanding of the state of the matches, we are going to utilize CPGA's live scoring tournament software (BlueGolf). We are hoping that someone in each match will be able to use their smartphone to enter hole-by-hole scores. That way, everyone can see how the matches are progressing. If using your personal smartphone is a problem, please let me know.

To enter scores, you won't need to download anything. CPGA will provide links for both iPhones and Androids. However, if you want to see the scores of other matches as quickly as possible, we encourage you to download the <u>free Carolinas PGA BlueGolf app</u> in iTunes or the Google Play Store.
