Starting Times

Starting times for September 30-Ocotober 1 will be available on Friday, September 23 by 5:00pm.

Practice Round

You are entitled to one practice round from September 23-29 when starting times are available. There is a <u>mandatory</u> \$25.00 cart/range fee for the practice round. Call the Mill Creek golf shop at 919-563-4653 starting September 16 to schedule a practice round. Make sure to identify yourself as a North Carolina Four-Ball Championship participant. It would be helpful if you make your own game before calling.

Push-Carts and Walking

Personal push-carts are allowed. Walking is permitted however remember that cart fees are included in the entry fee.

Food and Beverage

All food and beverage consumed on club grounds must be purchased at Mill Creek. Food and beverage will be available for championship contestants in the clubhouse grill. Personal coolers are not allowed.

CGA will host a lunch buffet on Friday, September 30 for all championship contestants. Details TBD.

Championship Format

Championship format is 54 holes of four-ball stroke play. After 36 holes, the field will be cut to the low 30 teams and ties for the final round.

Prizes

The championship team receives golf shop merchandise and trophies. Merchandise is awarded to the top 20 teams. Gift certificates expire on October 2, 2017.

Championship Schedule

September 23-29 Practice rounds available. Must call golf shop in advance for tee time.

Friday, September 30 Championship Round 1. Tee times off #1 and #10 tees starting at 8:00am/12:30pm. Saturday, October 1 Championship Round 2. Tee times off #1 and #10 tees starting at 8:00am/12:30pm.

Field cut to low 30 teams for final round.

Sunday, October 2 Championship Round 3. Tee times off #1 and #10 tees starting at 8:00am.

Awards ceremony following play at scoreboard.

Payout top 20 teams.

Lodging

Lodging is available at the Holiday Inn Hillsborough (919-644-7997) located approximately 18 minutes from the course. Please identify yourself with the "Carolinas Golf Association" or code "CGA" to receive the discounted rate of \$99.00 + tax for King room a Double Queen room. Hotel room rate is valid until September 1. Rooms and rates after the group cut-off date are subject to current rates and availability.

There are two hotels in Mebane near Mill Creek. They are not offering room block of rates and are subject to availability.

Policies and Rules

Mill Creek Golf Club is a spikeless facility. The penalty for non-compliance is disqualification. One-ball rule is not in effect. The "Notice to Players" rules sheet is available on the championship website.

Distance Measuring Devices: Local rule allowing the use of conforming distance measuring devices will be in effect (i.e. measure distance only). Note that if a smartphone or tablet is used as a distance measuring device, the distance measuring application must measure distance only and the device must not have any other applications that would render the device non-conforming (i.e. GPS altimeter or anemometer). Compass and weather applications are now permitted on the device.

Cell Phones: Except for emergencies, a ruling, viewing tournament leaderboard or use as a distance measuring device, cell phone use is not allowed on the golf course during championship rounds. Cell phone use is allowed outside the clubhouse or in the parking lot. Players are permitted to use their smartphone to view the tournament leaderboard as long as the device is on silent, is not used for voice or texting communications and play is not delayed.

Personal Items: Make sure not to leave any valuable personal items unattended such as jewelry, wallets, etc. even if they are tucked away inside your golf bag. It is best to leave your valuables locked in your automobile. Neither the CGA nor the host club will be held responsible for any lost or stolen personal items.

Text Notifications: The Carolinas Golf Association has a text (SMS) notification feature in the TPP tournament software that will be used to send text messages to your mobile phone in the event of tournament schedule changes, delays and cancelations. This is a free service provided by the CGA. Note that standard texting and data rates apply based upon your cell phone plan.
