Championship Format and Schedule

Championship is conducted at 54 holes of stroke play. After 36 holes, the field is cut to the low 60 scores and ties for the final round. An on-course play-off is used to break a tie for the championship. Top 30 scores will receive merchandise and are exempt into the 2017 Carolinas Senior Amateur Championship. Merchandise certificates are valid until December, 2016.

Sunday, September 11 AFTERNOON ONLY Tee times available for practice rounds. Must call golf shop in advance.

Monday, September 12 Round 1. Tee times at 8:00am/12:45pm off #1 and #10 tees.

Lunch in Banquet Formal Dining Room 11:00am-3:00pm Round 2. Tee times at 8:00am/12:45pm off #1 and #10 tees.

Tuesday, September 13 Round 2. Tee times at 8:00am/12:45pm off #1 and #10 tees.

Lunch in Banquet Formal Dining Room 11:00am-3:00pm Cut to low 60 scores and ties. Field re-paired according to score.

Wednesday, September 14 Round 3. Tee times begin at 8:00am off #1 and #10 tees.

Awards ceremony immediately following play at scoreboard.

Starting Times

Starting times for September 12-13 will be available on Thursday, September 8 by 5:00pm. Check the CGA website at www.carolinasgolf.org, call the CGA office or the Gaston Country Club golf shop.

Practice Rounds

You are entitled to <u>one</u> practice round on Sunday, September 11, **afternoon only** when tee times are available. You may call the golf shop beginning September 1st to schedule a practice round. Make sure to identify yourself as a Carolinas Senior Amateur Championship participant. It would be helpful if you make your own game before calling. There is a <u>mandatory</u> \$35.00 cart/range fee for the practice round.

Pull-Carts

Personal pull carts are **NOT** allowed.

Caddies and Spectators

Caddies are permitted but during the play of a hole, either the player or the caddie may ride in a golf cart but not both at the same time. Spectators are welcome at CGA championships however they are not allowed to ride in a player's golf cart at any time or rent a spectator cart except as provided in the CGA Tournament Manual. Club owned spectator carts are not allowed. Due to the limited number of available carts, spectator carts may not be available for any reason on September 12-13. Check with the CGA staff about cart availability.

Food and Beverage

All food and beverage consumed on club grounds must be purchased at Gaston Country Club. Food and beverage will be available for purchase at the Mens Grill/Turnhouse located in clubhouse. Personal coolers are not allowed.

Hosted Food Functions

Lunch will be provided for players only during rounds one and two only. Lunch will be served from 11:00am-3:00pm in the Formal Dining Room. Lunch can be purchased for others through Gaston CC.

Tournament Policies

Gaston Country Club is a spikeless facility. The penalty for non-compliance is disqualification. One-ball rule is not in effect. The "Notice to Players" rules sheet is available on the Carolinas Senior Amateur Championship home page.

Cell Phones: Except for emergencies, a ruling, viewing tournament leaderboard or use as a distance measuring device, cell phone use is not allowed on the golf course during championship rounds. Cell phone use is allowed outside the clubhouse or in the parking lot. Players are permitted to use their smartphone to view the tournament leaderboard as long as the device is on silent, is not used for voice or texting communications and play is not delayed.

Personal Items: Make sure not to leave any valuable personal items unattended such as jewelry, wallets, etc. even if they are tucked away inside your golf bag. It is best to leave your valuables locked in your automobile. Neither the CGA nor the host club will be held responsible for any lost or stolen personal items.

Text Notifications: The Carolinas Golf Association has a new text (SMS) notification feature in the TPP tournament software that will be used to send text messages to your mobile phone in the event of tournament schedule changes, delays and cancelations. This is a free service provided by the CGA. Note that standard texting and data rates apply based upon your cell phone plan.
