Coolers: No personal coolers

Dress Code: Shorts must be Bermuda-length, shirts must have a collar and be tucked in at all times. No denim of any kind is

allowed.

Personal Items: Make sure not to leave any valuable personal items unattended such as jewelry, wallets, etc. even if they are tucked away inside your golf bag. It is best to leave your valuables locked in your automobile. Neither the CGA nor the host club will be held responsible for any lost or stolen personal items.

Cell Phones: Except for emergencies, a ruling, viewing tournament leaderboard or use as a distance measuring device, cell phone use is not allowed on the golf course during championship rounds. Cell phone use is allowed outside the clubhouse or in the parking lot. Players are permitted to use their smartphone to view the tournament leaderboard as long as the device is on silent, is not used for voice or texting communications and play is not delayed.

Starting Times

Starting times for October 10 will be available on <u>Wednesday, October 5</u>. Check the CGA website at www.carolinasgolf.org, call the CGA office or Rock Hill Country Club golf shop.

Practice Round, Carts and Range Fees, Pull-Carts

You are entitled to one practice round on October 8-9 after 11:00am when tee times are available. You may call the golf shop starting <u>October 4 after 12:00pm</u> to schedule a practice round. Make sure to identify yourself as a Carolinas Super Senior Four-Ball Championship participant. It would be helpful if you make your own game before calling. There is a <u>mandatory</u> \$25.00 cart/range fee for the practice round.

All championship cart & range fees are included in the entry fee and will be paid by the CGA to the host club.

Contestants must use a cart during championship rounds.

Rock Hill CC accepts cash, check, MasterCard or Visa for practice round fees and golf shop purchases.

Food and Beverage, Awards Luncheon on October 11

All food and beverage consumed on club grounds must be purchased at Rock Hill Country Club. Food and beverage will be available for championship contestants in the club's Pro Shop Grill. Club accepts **Cash, Check, MasterCard and Visa** for food and beverage purchases. Personal coolers are not allowed.

CGA will host an awards luncheon for all players immediately following play on Monday, October 11.

Tipping

The CGA encourages players to tip club personnel particularly the outside staff when a service is performed (i.e. placing clubs on carts, cleaning clubs, etc.).

Championship Format and Schedule

Championship is conducted at 36 holes of four-ball stroke play. Top 15 overall teams receive merchandise at the conclusion of the championship. An on-course play-off is used to break a tie for the championship.

October 8-9 Practice rounds. Must call golf shop in advance for tee time.

Monday, October 10 First Round: 9:00am shotgun start. Repair field according to score for final round.

Tuesday, October 11 Final Round: 9:00am shotgun start. Hosted lunch and awards immediately following play.

Text Notifications: The Carolinas Golf Association has a new text (SMS) notification feature in the TPP tournament software that will be used to send text messages to your mobile phone in the event of tournament schedule changes, delays and cancelations. This is a free service provided by the CGA. Note that standard texting and data rates apply based upon your cell phone plan.
