

22nd North Carolina Junior Girls' Championship Maple Chase Golf & Country Club, Winston Salem, NC June 12-15, 2018

Entries Open: April 23 (8:00 pm) | Entry Fee: \$125 | Entries Close: June 4 (11:59 pm)

ELIGIBILITY

Entry is open to any female amateur golfer ages 12 to 18 as of June 15, 2018, who has not started college, is a legal resident of North Carolina, is a member in good standing of a club which is a member of the Carolinas Golf Association (CGA) and has a current USGA Handicap Index® at a CGA member club. Entries are subject to rejection at any time, including during the event, by the CGA or the host club. The reason for rejection may include unbecoming conduct or cell phone use during a stipulated round. All players must conform to the "USGA Rules of Amateur Status" as specified in the "Rules of Golf". For complete eligibility requirements, refer to the CGA Tournament Manual.

Championship field size - 90 players

ENTRIES

All players must register online. Entries are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Fax, e-mail, telephone, incomplete, or entries received after the closing date are not accepted. Entries are only accepted between the open and close dates as stated above. Players who "Did Not Show" (DNS) or "No Card" (NC) are suspended from the following year's North Carolina Junior Girls' Championship.

RULES

USGA Rules of Golf govern play. Questions will be decided by the on-site Rules Committee whose decision will be final. Notice to Players and local rules are posted at host club and distributed at the starting tee(s). The CGA reserves the right to alter the conditions or schedules as stated, including alteration of the stipulated round(s) at any time during the championship. The competition is closed when the championship trophy has been presented. Special requests for starting times or pairings are not granted.

REFUND POLICY

Players in the championship will receive a refund minus a \$30 administrative fee if withdrawing prior to the first day of the championship. No refunds are given on or after the first day of the championship for any reason. Alternates not gaining entry into the tournament will receive a full refund.

INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY

Every effort will be made to complete all rounds. There are no guaranteed refunds if the tournament is shortened due to weather. If the entire tournament is cancelled, a full refund will be issued to all players.

PRIZES

Trophies are awarded to the champion, runner-up, semifinalists, quarterfinalists and stroke play qualifying medalist. Ties in stroke play qualifying for match play spots will be determined by an on-course playoff.

FORMAT

36 holes of stroke play qualifying followed by match play. Top 32 in stroke play qualifying advance to match play. When a player loses a match, she is eliminated from the competition. There are no consolation matches.

YARDAGES & DIVISIONS

All competitors will compete in the same division and play from approximately 6,000 yards.

MID-ATLANTIC GIRLS' TEAM MATCHES

The champion will be invited to represent the Carolinas in the Mid-Atlantic Girls' Challenge Team Matches at Indian Creek Golf & Yacht Club in Kilmarnock, VA on July 31-August 1, 2018.
