

## Carolinas Golf Association 2018 Ladies' Race to the Carolinas Cup

The Race to the Carolinas Cup is a season-long points competition in which players accumulate points based on team finish and participation in CGA Ladies' Four-Ball Play Days. At the end of the regular season, the winning player (player with the most points) will be named Carolinas Cup Champion. The Carolinas Cup Tournament, which will be held at Kiawah Island Resort (Ocean Course) on December 3, 2018 will cap off the Race to the Carolinas Cup season.

## **Points Eligibility**

Players will receive points based on team finish and participation in <u>CGA Ladies' Four-Ball Play Days (click to see schedule)</u>. Points will be awarded to <u>all teams in each flight</u> based on gross and net finishes. Teams will only receive points for their gross <u>OR</u> net finish (whichever place awards more points). All team points will be split between players. All players who compete in the event will receive participation points in addition to other points awarded.

Example: Player A + Player B on a team – Win First Gross prize

Team points = 100 points (first gross) + 40 points (participation) = 140 team points Player A = 50 points (first gross) + 20 points (participation) = 70 individual points Player B = 50 points (first gross) + 20 points (participation) = 70 individual points

## **Carolinas Cup Champion**

At the end of the Race to the Carolinas Cup regular season (November 15, 2018), the player with the most points will be named the Carolinas Cup Champion. In the event of a tie, multiple champions will be named. This award will be given at the year-end Carolinas Cup Tournament.

## **Carolinas Cup Tournament**

The 2018 Carolinas Cup Tournament will be held at Kiawah Island Resort (Ocean Course) on December 4, 2018. The tournament will consist of 18 holes of four-ball stroke play competition with gross and net prizes. For format and rules information, see the <u>Ladies' Four-Ball Play Day Rules and Policies</u>. Lunch and a tee gift will be provided for all participants.

**Eligibility:** Any player who was part of a winning side (gross and net) in any flight in any CGA Ladies' Four-Ball Play Day is eligible to compete in the Carolinas Cup Tournament. In addition, any player in the Top 50 of the Race to the Carolinas Cup standings (as of November 15, 2018) is also eligible. <u>Players may choose any eligible player to compete as their partner in the Carolinas Cup Tournament.</u>

**Entry Information:** Entry for the Carolinas Cup Tournament will be open on November 19, 2018 at 8:00 p.m. Players will be notified by November 15, 2018 that they are eligible for the Carolinas Cup Tournament. Entries will be accepted on a first-come. first-served basis.

**Prizes and Merchandise:** Merchandise is awarded for low gross and net scores in all flights. Additional prizes will be awarded based on the number of entries. Merchandise certificates are redeemable only at the host club's golf shop. Ties will be broken using the USGA recommended scorecard method.
