ELIGIBILITY AND FIELD SIZE

Entry is open to any female amateur golfer ages 12 to 18 as of June 27, 2019, who has not started college, maintains a residence in North Carolina or South Carolina, is a member in good standing of a club which is a member of the Carolinas Golf Association (CGA) and has a current USGA Handicap Index® at a CGA member club. Entries are subject to rejection at any time, including during the event, by the CGA or the host club. The reason for rejection may include unbecoming conduct as defined by the <u>CGA Code of Conduct Policy</u> or cell phone use during a round. All players must conform to the "USGA Rules of Amateur Status" as specified in the "Rules of Golf". For complete residency and eligibility requirements, refer to the <u>CGA Tournament Manual</u>.

REGISTRATION POLICIES

All players must register online at <u>www.carolinasgolf.org</u>. Mail-in applications are not accepted for this event. Fax, mail, e-mail, telephone, incomplete, illegible, or entries received before the opening date and after the closing date, are not accepted.

The CGA is not responsible for errors or delays by any internet service provider. Entries are only accepted between the open and close dates as stated above. Confirmation of acceptance is sent to players when their status is determined. The appropriate entry fee must be paid at time of registration. Players who "Did Not Show" (DNS) or "No Card" (NC) are suspended from next year's Twin States Junior Girls' Championship.

REFUND POLICY

Entry fee refund policy schedule:

Open Date to Day Prior to Championship or Qualifying Date: Full refund minus \$30 administrative fee regardless of reason if entry accepted into championship.

Withdraw on Championship Date; No-Shows: No refund for any reason.

INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY

Every effort will be made to complete all rounds of the tournament. There are no refunds if the tournament is shortened due to weather. If the entire tournament is cancelled, a full refund will be issued to all players.

CHAMPIONSHIP FORMAT

The championship format is 36 holes of stroke play competition.

YARDAGES AND DIVISIONS

All competitors will compete in the same division and play from approximately 6,000 yards.

<u>RULES</u>

USGA Rules of Golf govern play. Questions will be decided by the on-site Rules Committee whose decision will be final. Notice to Players and local rules are posted at host club and distributed at the starting tee(s). The CGA reserves the right to alter the conditions or schedules as stated, including alteration of the round(s) at any time during the championship including sectional qualifying. The competition is closed when the championship trophy has been presented. Special requests for starting times or pairings are not granted.

FLIGHTS

The field will be flighted after 18 holes. Flight sizes will be based on number of participants. The Committee reserves the right to make adjustments in the size of each flight.

PRIZES

Trophies are awarded to the overall champion and the overall runner-up. Trophies are also awarded to the top three players in each flight. A tie for the overall championship is decided by an on-course playoff. All other ties for trophies will be broken by scorecard playoff.

The champion will be invited to represent the Carolinas in the Mid-Atlantic Girls' Challenge Team Matches at Brook Valley Country Club in Greenville, NC on August 10-11, 2019.
