ELIGIBILITY AND FIELD SIZE

Entry is open to any female amateur golfer ages 12 to 18 as of June 19, 2020, who has not started college, is a legal resident of North Carolina, is a member in good standing of a club which is a member of the Carolinas Golf Association (CGA) and has a current USGA Handicap Index® at a CGA member club. Entries are subject to rejection at any time, including during the event, by the CGA or the host club. The reason for rejection may include unbecoming conduct as defined by the [CGA Code of Conduct Policy](#) or cell phone use during a round. All players must conform to the "USGA Rules of Amateur Status" as specified in the "Rules of Golf". For complete residency and eligibility requirements, refer to the [CGA Tournament Manual](#).

ENTRY FEES, ENTRY WINDOW AND REGISTRATION POLICIES

Entry Fee: \$150

Entries Open: April 28 at 8:00pm

Entries Close: June 9 at 11:59pm

All players must register online at www.carolinagolf.org. Mail-in applications are not accepted for this event. Fax, mail, e-mail, telephone, incomplete, illegible, or entries received before the opening date and after the closing date, are not accepted.

The CGA is not responsible for errors or delays by any internet service provider. Entries are only accepted between the open and close dates as stated above. Confirmation of acceptance is sent to players when their status is determined. The appropriate entry fee must be paid at time of registration. **Players who "Did Not Show" (DNS) or "No Card" (NC) are suspended from next year's NC Junior Girls' Championship.**

REFUND POLICY (NEW)

Entry fee refund policy schedule:

Open Date to Two Days Prior to Championship First Round Date: Full refund minus \$30.00 administrative fee refunded regardless of reason if entry accepted into championship.

Withdraw Day Prior or on Championship First Round Date: No refund for any reason.

Alternates: Full refund if player does not gain entry into championship.

INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY

Every effort will be made to complete all rounds of the tournament. There are no refunds if the tournament is shortened due to weather. If the entire tournament is cancelled, a full refund will be issued to all players.

RULES

USGA Rules of Golf govern play. Questions will be decided by the on-site Rules Committee whose decision will be final. Notice to Players and local rules are posted at host club and distributed at the starting tee(s). The CGA reserves the right to alter the conditions or schedules as stated, including alteration of the round(s) at any time during the championship including sectional qualifying. The competition is closed when the championship trophy has been presented. Special requests for starting times or pairings are not granted.

CHAMPIONSHIP FORMAT

The championship format is 36 holes of stroke play qualifying followed by match play. Top 32 in stroke play qualifying advance to match play. Players will be seeded based on qualifying score. All ties for seeds 1-31 will be broken by blind draw. Ties in stroke play qualifying for the last spot in match play will be broken by an on-course playoff. When a player loses a match, she is eliminated from the competition. There are no consolation matches.

YARDAGES AND DIVISIONS

All competitors will compete in the same division and play from approximately 6,000 yards.

PRIZES

Trophies are awarded to the champion, runner-up, semifinalists, quarterfinalists and stroke play qualifying medalist. Ties for stroke play qualifying medalist will receive co-medalist honors.

MID-ATLANTIC GIRLS' TEAM MATCHES

The champion will be invited to represent the Carolinas in the Mid-Atlantic Girls' Challenge Team Matches at Danville Golf Club in Danville, VA on August 8-9, 2020.
