48th South Carolina Amateur Match Play

Conducted by the Carolinas Golf Association Orangeburg Country Club, Orangeburg, SC June 17-21, 2020



ELIGIBILITY AND FIELD SIZE

Entry is open to any male amateur golfer who has reached his 13th birthday by June 17, 2020, and is a legal resident of South Carolina, is a member in good standing of a club which is a member of the Carolinas Golf Association (CGA) and has an active USGA Handicap Index® that does not exceed **10.4** at a CGA member club. Entries are subject to rejection at any time, including during the event, by the CGA or the host club. The reason for rejection may include unbecoming conduct as defined in the <u>CGA Code of Conduct Policy</u> for current or future championships. All players must conform to the "USGA Rules of Amateur Status" as specified in "The Rules of Golf".

College Student Eligibility: A college student is considered a resident of their parent(s)/guardian(s) "Legal Residency Criteria" as stated in the CGA Tournament Manual unless said student (a) has no dependency on his/her parents; and (b) lives full time in South Carolina.

For complete residency and eligibility requirements, refer to the CGA Tournament Manual.

Championship Field Size: 144 Players.

ENTRY FEES (All Course Fees Paid by the CGA to the Host Club)

Championship Entry Fee: \$215.00 (includes cart/range fees and lunch) Carolinas Amateur Qualifying Entry Fee: \$60*

ENTRY WINDOW AND ONLINE REGISTRATION

Exempt Entry Window*: Open March 30 at 8:00pm | Close June 4 at 11:59pm

Non-Exempt/Open Entry Window: Open April 20 at 8:00pm | Close June 4 at 11:59pm

All players, including those exempt, must register online at www.carolinasgolf.org. Mail-in applications are not accepted for this event. Fax, mail, e-mail, telephone, incomplete, illegible, or entries received before the opening date and after the closing date, are not accepted.

Entries are accepted on a first come, first serve basis.

*Exempt players must register between 8:00pm on March 30 and 7:59pm on April 20 to ensure acceptance. Exempt players that sign up after 8:00pm on April 20 and non-exempt players gain entry into the tournament on a first come first serve basis.

The CGA is not responsible for errors or delays by any internet service provider. Entries are only accepted between the open and close dates as stated above. Confirmation of acceptance and tournament information is sent to players when their status has been determined. The appropriate entry fee must be paid at time of registration. Status may be checked at www.carolinasgolf.org. Teams who "Did Not Show" (DNS) or "No Card" (NC) are suspended from next year's North Carolina Super Senior Four-Ball Championship.

REFUND POLICY

Entry fee refund policy schedule:

Open Date to Two Days Prior to Championship Date: Full refund minus \$30.00 administrative fee refunded regardless of reason if entry accepted into championship.

Withdraw Day Prior or on Championship Date: No refund for any reason.

Alternates: Full refund if player does not gain entry into championship.

RULES

USGA Rules of Golf govern play. Questions will be decided by the on-site Rules Committee whose decision will be final. Notice to Players and local rules are posted at host club and distributed at the starting tee(s). The CGA reserves the right to alter the conditions or schedules as stated, including alteration of the round(s) at any time during the championship including sectional qualifying. The competition is closed when the championship trophy has been presented. Special requests for starting times or pairings are not granted.

COURSE FEES; GOLF CARTS; CADDIES; SPECTATORS

Championship Site: All championship site cart/range fees are paid by the CGA and included in the entry fee for both stroke play qualifying and match play rounds. Competitors have the option to either walk or use a golf cart during championship rounds.

Practice Rounds: Cart rental is mandatory for practice rounds.

Caddies: Caddies are allowed. A player may provide his own caddie. Caddies will not be available at host club. Caddie must be over the age of 13.

Caddie/Spectator Cart Policy: During the play of a hole, either the player or his caddie may ride in a golf cart but not both at the same time. Spectators are not allowed to ride in a player's golf cart at any time. Club owned spectator carts are not allowed except as provided in the CGA Tournament Manual.

Exception: During the match play portion of the championship both the player and caddie may ride in a golf cart at the same time.

CHAMPIONSHIP FORMAT

The championship is contested at 36 holes of individual stroke play to determine 32 qualifiers for Match Play. 5 Rounds of Match Play to determine champion.

PRIZES

Champion receives a trophy, merchandise and has name engraved on permanent championship trophy for the ensuing year. Trophy and merchandise is awarded to the runner-up and stroke play qualifying medalist(s). Merchandise is awarded to players who advance to match play.

EXEMPTIONS

Players in the following categories are exempt into the championship if otherwise eligible. A complete list of exempt players is available on the championship website.

CHAMPIONSHIP SCHEDULE

Tuesday, June 16

Tee times available for practice.

Wednesday, June 17

First round of stroke play qualifying and optional *Carolinas Amateur Qualifying.

Thursday, June 18

Second round of stroke play qualifying. Cut to low 32 players for match play, playoff if necessary. Friday, June 19

First and second round of match play (18 holes each round).

Saturday, June 20

Quarterfinal and semifinal rounds of match play (18 holes each round). Sunday, June 21 Championship match (18 holes).

*CAROLINAS AMATEUR QUALIFYING

A Carolinas Amateur Championship qualifier is held in conjunction with round one of the SC Amateur Match Play on June 17, 2020. Players may compete in both events as long as they have registered for both events. Those who are successful in qualifying for the Carolinas Amateur will be charge an additional championship entry fee for the Carolinas Amateur Championship.
