

14th North Carolina Super Senior Championship

Conducted by the Carolinas Golf Association

Greensboro Country Club (Farm), Greensboro, NC September 13-14, 2022

ELIGIBILITY AND FIELD SIZE

Entry is open to any male amateur golfer who has reached his 65th birthday by September 13, 2022, is a legal resident of North Carolina, is a member in good standing of a club which is a member of the Carolinas Golf Association (CGA) and has an active USGA Handicap Index® that does not exceed **9.9** at a CGA member club. Entries are subject to rejection at any time, including during the event, by the CGA or the host club. The reason for rejection may include unbecoming conduct as defined in the <u>CGA Code of Conduct Policy</u> for current or future championships. All players must conform to the "USGA Rules of Amateur Status" as specified in "The Rules of Golf".

For complete residency and eligibility requirements, refer to the <u>CGA Tournament</u> <u>Manual</u>.

Championship Field Size: 104 Players.

ENTRY FEES (All Course Fees Paid by the CGA to the Host Club)
Championship Entry Fee: \$170 (includes cart/range fees and lunch)

ENTRY WINDOW AND ONLINE REGISTRATION

Exempt Early Entry Window*: Open July 11 at 8:00pm | Close July 24 at 11:59pm

Non-Exempt/Open Entry Window: Open July 25 at 8:00pm | Close September 5 at 11:59pm

All players, including those exempt, must register online at www.carolinasgolf.org. Mail-in applications are not accepted for this event. Fax, mail, e-mail, telephone, incomplete, illegible, or entries received before the opening date and after the closing date, are not accepted.

Entries are accepted on a first come, first serve basis.

*Exempt players must register between 8:00pm on July 11 and 11:59pm on July 24 to ensure acceptance. Exempt players that sign up after 8:00pm on July 25 and non-exempt players gain entry into the tournament on a first come first serve basis.

The CGA is not responsible for errors or delays by any internet service provider. Entries are only accepted between the open and close dates as stated above. Confirmation of acceptance and tournament information is sent to players when their status has been determined. The appropriate entry fee must be paid at time of registration. Status may be checked at www.carolinasgolf.org. Teams who "Did Not Show" (DNS) or "No Card" (NC) are suspended from next year's championship.

REFUND POLICY

Entry fee refund policy schedule:

Open Date to Two Days Prior to Championship First Round Date: Full refund minus \$30 administrative fee refunded regardless of reason if entry accepted into championship

Withdraw Day Prior or on Championship First Round Date: No refund for any reason. Alternates: Full refund if player does not gain entry into championship.

RULES

USGA Rules of Golf govern play. Questions will be decided by the on-site Rules Committee whose decision will be final. Notice to Players and local rules are posted at host club and distributed at the starting tee(s). The CGA reserves the right to alter the conditions or schedules as stated, including alteration of the round(s) at any time during the championship including sectional qualifying. The competition is closed when the championship trophy has been presented. Special requests for starting times or pairings are not granted.

COURSE FEES; GOLF CARTS; CADDIES; SPECTATORS

Practice Rounds: Cart rental is mandatory for practice rounds. Competitors pay host club directly for practice round fees.

Championship Rounds: Championship round cart & range fees and final round lunch is included in the entry fee. Competitors must use a golf cart during championship rounds.

Caddies: Refer to Player Information for specific Qualifier or Championship site.

Caddie/Spectator Cart Policy: Since players are required to use a golf cart at this event, caddies will be required to walk. Spectators are not allowed to ride in a player's golf cart at any time. Club owned spectator carts are not allowed except as provided in the CGA Tournament Manual.

CHAMPIONSHIP FORMAT

The championship is contested at 36 holes of individual stroke play. Gross scores only. A tie for the 65+ Division or 70+ Division is decided by an on-course playoff. Players may select the division in which to compete if eligible:

65+ Division (Men Age 65+): Approximate yardage = 6100 yards.

70+ Division (Men Age 70+): Approximate yardage = 5500 yards.

Yardage subject to change.

PRIZE9

The 65+ and 70+ Champions receive trophies & merchandise. Merchandise will be awarded to the top players in each championship based upon field sizes. Ties are split except for the 65+ winners and 70+ champions, which is resolved using an oncourse play-off.

EXEMPTIONS*

Players in the following categories are exempt into the championship if otherwise eligible and able to sign up early to guarantee a spot in the field. A complete list of exempt players is available on the championship website.

- 1. Champions of the Carolinas Senior Amateur Championship since 2011.
- 2. Champions of the North Carolina Senior Amateur Championship since 2011.
- 3. Champions of the North Carolina Super Senior 65+ and 70+ Championship since 2016.
- 4. Champions of the Carolinas Super Senior 65+ and 70+ Championship since 2017.
- 5. Players who finished 20th or better in the $65+\,$ Division at the 2021 North Carolina Super Senior Championship.
- 6. Players who finished 20th or better in the 70+ Division at the 2021 North Carolina Super Senior Championship.
- 7. Players who finished 10th or better in the 65+ Division at the 2022 Carolinas Super Senior Championship.
 8. Players who finished 10th or better in the 70+ Division at the 2022 Carolinas
- Super Senior Championship.

 9. Players ranked in the top 35 of the Carolinas Super Senior Men's Amateur Rankings
- as of the opening date.
- 10. Players who competed in a 2021 USGA Championship Proper.
- 11. Two exemptions for championship host club.
- 12. Special exemption bestowed by the CGA.

*Exempt players must register between 8:00pm on July 11 and 11:59pm on July 24 to ensure acceptance. Exempt players that sign up after 8:00pm on July 25 and non-exempt players gain entry into the tournament on a first come first serve basis.

Tee times available for practice in afternoon.

Tuesday, September 13

First round. 18 holes of stroke play.

Wednesday, September 14

Final round. 18 holes of stroke play.

Awards luncheon immediately following completion of play.
