

25th Carolinas Parent-Child

Conducted by the Carolinas Golf Association

Pinehurst Area Courses Friday, July 22, 2022

ELIGIBILITY

Entry is open to any team comprised of a parent and child, regardless of age, in any gender combination excluding male-male. Step-parents, grandparents and in-laws are eligible. At least one member of each team must: 1. be a legal resident of one of the Carolinas; 2. be a member in good standing of a club which is a member of the Carolinas Golf Association (CGA) and have an active GHIN® USGA Handicap Index® at a CGA member club or is a golf professional employed at a CGA member club. A team is eligible if one partner is an amateur member of a CGA member club or if one partner is a golf professional employed by a CGA member club. Pro-Pro teams are NOT eligible. Entries are subject to rejection at any time, including during the event, by the CGA or the host club. The reason for rejection may include unbecoming conduct. The minimum age for entry is eight years as of the tournament date. For complete residency and eligibility requirements, refer to the CGA Tournament Manual.

ENTRIES

All entries must be completed online. <u>Fax, mail, e-mail, telephone, incomplete, illegible, or entries received before the opening date and after the closing date, are not accepted.</u>

The first 50 entries are accepted on a first come, first served basis. Alternate teams are ranked according to order of entry. Site information and starting times will be sent at least 5 days before the championship date.

The CGA is not responsible for errors or delays in internet service providers. Entries are only accepted between the open and close dates as stated above. Confirmation of acceptance and tournament information is sent to the players when their status has been determined. Status may be checked at www.carolinasgolf.org. The entry fee must be paid by each team and must accompany this form. Only one entry fee per check. Make check payable to the Carolinas Golf Association. Teams who "Did Not Show" (DNS) or "No Card" (NC) are suspended from next year's Carolinas Parent-Child Championship.

REFUND POLICY

Entry fee refund policy schedule:

Open Date to TWO Days Prior to Championship Date: Full refund minus \$30.00 administrative fee regardless of reason if entry accepted into championship.

Withdraw on Day Prior or on Championship Date; No-Shows: No refund for any reason.

Alternates: Full refund if player does not gain entry into the championship.

KULES

USGA Rules of Golf govern play. Questions will be decided by the on-site Rules Committee whose decision will be final. Notice to Players and local rules are posted at host club and distributed at the starting tee(s). The CGA reserves the right to alter the conditions or schedules as stated, including alteration of the stipulated round(s) at any time during the championship including sectional qualifying. The competition is closed when the championship trophy has been presented. Special requests for starting times or pairings are not granted.

CART FEES; GOLF CARTS; CADDIES; SPECTATORS

Practice Rounds: Cart rental is mandatory for practice rounds. Competitors pay host club directly for practice round fees.

Championship Rounds: Championship round cart & range fees is included in the entry fee. Competitors must use a golf cart during championship rounds.

Caddies: Caddies are NOT allowed for championship rounds.

Caddie/Spectator Cart Policy: Caddies are not allowed. Spectators are not allowed to ride in a player's golf cart at any time. Club owned spectator carts are not allowed except as provided in the CGA Tournament Manual.

FORMAT AND YARDAGES*

Each team plays alternate shot except that both team members hit from each tee and then select the ball to be played (modified alternate shot). A team must complete the hole with the ball selected.

Teams select the division in which to compete if eligible:

Amateur Division: Team comprised of two amateurs. Overall champions are determined from this division. Gross scores only. Flights are determined by team handicap index*.

- Male team member age 14 or older: 6100 yards
- Female team member(s) age 14-49: 5200 yards
- Team member ages 12-13 or female team member(s) age 50+: 4800

Open (Pro-Am) Division: Team comprised of one golf professional and one amateur (or an amateur awaiting reinstatement "A/R"). Open division competes at gross and net. Net scores are calculated using 40% of the amateur partners' course handicap. Golf professionals play at scratch handicap.

- Professional male team member: 6500
- Professional female team member: 5200
- Male team member age 14 or older: 6100 yards
- Female team member(s) age 14-49: 5200 yards
- Team member ages 12-13 or female team member(s) age 50+: 4800

*Note: yardage is subject to change

**Team handicap index is computed by adding 2/3 of the lower handicap index to 1/3 of the higher handicap index.

Note: CGA reserves the right to adjust the format dependent upon the number of entries.

PRIZES

Trophies and merchandise is awarded to the overall champion in each division. Merchandise is distributed to top teams in each amateur flight. Open division merchandise is distributed based on the size of the field to both professionals and amateurs. Ties for prizes are split except for the overall champion in each division, which is determined by an on-course playoff.

Note: Collegiate and high school contestants should check with their school's compliance department regarding rules regarding accepting merchandise certificates. Amateurs awaiting reinstatement are not eligible to receive merchandise certificates.

EXEMPTIONS

There are no exemptions for this championship.

Tee times available at assigned course for practice rounds.

Friday, July 22

Championship round. 18 holes of modified alternate shot.
