ELIGIBILITY

Entry is open to any male or female amateur golfer who is 18 years of age or younger, has not yet enrolled in college, maintains a residence in North Carolina or South Carolina, is a member or their parent is a member in good standing of a club which is a member of the Carolinas Golf Association (CGA) and has a current USGA handicap index[®] at a CGA member club. Entries are subject to rejection at any time, including during the event, by the CGA or the host club. The reason for rejection may include unbecoming conduct as defined in the CGA Code of Conduct Policy for current or future championships. All players must conform to the "USGA Rules of Amateur Status" as specified in "The Rules of Golf".

For complete residency and eligibility requirements, refer to the CGA Tournament Manual.

FIELD SIZE

160 players; 120 spots reserved for Boys': 40 spots will be reserved for Girls' division

ENTRY FEE

Showcase Entry Fee: \$195.00

ENTRIES AND ONLINE REGISTRATION

Exempt Entry: Open September 20 at 8:00pm | Close October 26 at 11:59pm

Open Entry: Open October 4 at 8:00pm | Close October 26 at 11:59pm

All players must register online at www.carolinasgolf.org. Mail-in applications are no longer accepted for this event. Fax, mail, e-mail, telephone, incomplete, illegible, or entries received before the opening date and after the closing date, are not accepted.

The CGA is not responsible for errors or delays by any internet service provider. Entries are only accepted between the open and close dates as stated above. Confirmation of acceptance is sent to players when their status is determined. Status may be checked at www.carolinasgolf.org. The appropriate entry fee must be paid by each player at time of registration. Players who "Did Not Show" (DNS) or "No Card" (NC) are suspended from next year's Carolinas Junior Boys' or Junior Girls' Championship.

REFUND POLICY (NEW)

Entry fee refund policy schedule:

Open Date to Two Days Prior to Showcase First Round Date: Full refund minus \$30.00 administrative fee refunded regardless of reason if entry accepted into championship.

Withdraw Day Prior or on Showcase First Round Date: No refund for any reason.

Alternates: Full refund if player does not gain entry into championship.

RULES

USGA Rules of Golf govern play. Questions will be decided by the on-site Rules Committee whose decision will be final. Notice to Players and local rules are posted at host club and distributed at the starting tee(s). The CGA reserves the right to alter the conditions or schedules as stated, including alteration of the stipulated round(s) at any time during the championship. The competition is closed when the championship trophy has been presented. Special requests for starting times or pairings are not granted.

AUTOMOTIVE TRANSPORTATION; CADDIES; SPECTATORS

Transportation: Players must walk at all times, except for Committee approved shuttles.

Caddies: No caddies are allowed at this event.

Spectators: Spectators are welcome at CGA championships. Spectator carts will be available for rent for \$30 per day. Carts must remain on the cart path and out of

PRIZES

Trophies are awarded to the top 3 players in each division.

AGE DIVISIONS

There are no age divisions. All Boys will compete in one division and all Girls will compete in one division.

FORMAT

The showcase format is 36-holes of stroke play. An 8:30am shotgun start will be utilized to begin play on each day.

YARDAGE

Course yardage is approximately 7,000 yards for Boys and 6,200 yards for Girls.
