ELIGIBILITY

Entry is open to any team comprised of a golf professional and a junior golfer between the ages of 8-18 as of the day of the championship who has not started college. The professional and junior golfer must be legal residents of North or South Carolina. Golf Professional does not have to be a member of the Carolinas PGA. Entries are subject to rejection at any time, including during the event, by the CGA or the host club. The reason for rejection may include unbecoming conduct. For complete residency and eligibility requirements, refer to the CGA Tournament Manual at www.carolinasgolf.org.

RULES

USGA Rules of Golf govern play. Local rules are distributed at the starter's table. CGA reserves the right to alter the conditions or schedules as stated, including alteration of the stipulated round at any time during the championship. Note: The use of cellular phones (except in the case of an emergency or a ruling), portable music devices, headphones, laptop computers, PDA's, pagers, beepers, and the like are not allowed during a stipulated round. The competition is closed when the championship trophy has been presented.

FORMAT, PRIZES AND STARTING TIMES

Format is 18-holes of Pinehurst Foursomes. A team must then complete the hole with the ball selected. Golf Professionals will play from the same set of tees and the junior will play from tees based on gender and age. Female professionals and professionals over the age of 60 may play a shorter set of tee designated by the committee. Trophies will be awarded to the champion team, the runner-up team and the second runner-up team. All play will begin with a 9:00 am shotgun start.

ENTRIES

Each team must complete an online application at www.carolinasgolf.org. No entry is accepted prior to the opening date. The field is limited to 50 teams. The first 48 teams to register are accepted into the tournament. The Country Club at Wakefield Plantation receives 1 spot in the tournament field. Entries are accepted until 11:59 p.m. of the closing date. The CGA is not responsible for errors or delays by any Internet service provider. Confirmation of acceptance and lodging information is sent to the golf professional listed on this form when the field is filled or after entries close. Status may be checked at www.carolinasgolf.org. Fax, mailed, e-mail, telephone, late or incomplete entries are not accepted. The entry fee must be paid by each team. Teams who "Did Not Show" (DNS) or "No Card" (NC) jeopardize their entry into future CGA championships.

REFUND POLICY

Entry fee refund policy schedule:

Open Date to Two Days Prior to Championship or Qualifying Date: Full refund minus \$30.00 administrative fee regardless of reason if entry accepted into championship or sectional qualifier.

Withdraw on day before or Championship or Qualifying Date; No-Shows: No refund for any reason. *Alternates:* Full refund if player does not gain entry into a qualifying site.
