ENTRY FEES AND ENTRY WINDOW

Entry Fee:

\$150 (Championship or Junior Division)

\$100 (Sub-Junior Division)

Entries Open: June 10 at 8:00pm Entries Close: July 15 at 11:59pm

ELIGIBILITY AND FIELD SIZE

Entry is open to any female amateur golfer who has not reached her 16th birthday as of the date of the final round, who has not started college, and maintains a residence in North Carolina or South Carolina. Entries are subject to rejection at any time, including during the event, by the CGA or the host club. The reason for rejection may include unbecoming conduct as defined by the CGA Code of Conduct Policy or unauthorized cell phone use during a round. All players must conform to the "USGA Rules of Amateur Status" as specified in the "Rules of Golf". For complete residency and eligibility requirements, refer to the CGA Tournament Manual.

ENTRIES AND ONLINE REGISTRATION

All players must register online at www.carolinasgolf.org. Mail-in applications are not accepted for this event. Fax, mail, e-mail, telephone, incomplete, illegible, or entries received before the opening date and after the closing date, are not accepted. The CGA is not responsible for errors or delays by any internet service provider. Entries are only accepted between the open and close dates as stated above. Confirmation of acceptance is sent to players when their status is determined. The appropriate entry fee must be paid at time of registration. Players who "Did Not Show" (DNS) or "No Card" (NC) are suspended from next year's Twin States Junior Girls' Championship.

NEW REFUND POLICY

Entry fee refund policy schedule:

- Open Date to THREE Days Prior to Championship or Qualifying Date: Full refund minus \$30.00 administrative fee regardless of reason if entry accepted into championship or sectional qualifier.
- Withdrawals submitted less than three days before the Championship or Qualifying Date: No refund for any reason.
- No-Shows: No refund for any reason.

RULES

USGA Rules of Golf govern play. Questions will be decided by the on-site Rules Committee whose decision will be final. Notice to Players and local rules are posted at host club and distributed at the starting tee(s). The CGA reserves the right to alter the conditions or schedules as stated, including alteration of the round(s) at any time during the championship. The competition is closed when the championship trophy has been presented. Special requests for starting times or pairings are not granted.

DIVISIONS

CHAMPIONSHIP DIVISION: Any player (regardless of age) is eligible to compete for the overall championship. Championship Division will play 18 holes each day at approximately 5,600 yards.

JUNIOR DIVISION: Any player (regardless of age) is eligible to compete in the junior division. Junior Division will play 18 holes each day at approximately 5,300 yards.

SUB-JUNIOR DIVISION: Any player who is 12 years of age or younger as of the date of the final round is eligible to play in the sub-junior division. Sub-Junior Division will play 9 holes each day at approximately 2,400 yards.

*Note: Players 12 years of age or younger are allowed to play in the Championship or Junior divisions.

CHAMPIONSHIP FORMAT

The championship and Junior divisions are conducted at 36 holes of stroke play. The Sub-Junior division is conducted at 18 holes of stroke play (9 holes each day).

PRIZES

Trophies are awarded to the top three players in each division. Prizes are also given to the most improved player (from the previous year) in each division and medalists after the first round in each division.

TRANSPORTATION, CADDIES, SPECTATORS

Transportation: Players must walk at all times during the

championship.

Caddies: Caddies are NOT allowed.

Spectators: Spectators are welcome at CGA championships. Spectator cart availability and cost is at the host clubs' discretion. If allowed, spectator carts must remain on the cart path and out of the way of play.
