

HOW TO USE MAP LEGEND

DETAIL GREEN VIEW


- Compass represents True North
- Sprinkler head for orientation
- Arrows point downhill
- Numbers and colors indicate % of slope
- Depth of green in 1 and 5 yard grids



Angle of Approach is rotated to back tee used on par 3 holes, to middle of fairway at 100 yard marker on par 5 holes (or to 2nd shot in some instances) and to dogleg or 150 yard marker on par 4 holes.


DETAIL HEATMAP VIEW

- Represents the front of the green
- White line represents center line of green
- Indicates back of green on straight line from front
- Colors represent slope. In this example, the grey and blue areas would indicate least amount of slope



Green grids are scaled to $3/8'' = 5$ yards per square and are in compliance with the requirements of the rules of golf. If greens are on their own page, they are still allowable under the max scale.


Compass represents True North




Tee shots are measured from this symbol (typically back of tee). Distance rings (off the tee) also are drawn from this point. Example: the back of the 2nd tee would be -32

Tee Shot

Indicates elevation difference between tee used and likely landing area (225-300)



Arrows in fairway indicate directional slope and contours 4% and higher



Elevation change (in yards) +/- to center of the green. For example, this shot you would laser your yardage and subtract 2 yards for the downhill.

Distance to front of the green






Distance measured from penalty area to penalty area. This is the width (in yards) with the crosshairs and number being the center aiming point. If none are present, you know what to do.






Distance rings to green are measured to the front. Distance rings off tee are measured from .


All yardage is measured in yards unless indicated by "Meters" written on the front of the book






























