# Subject: 2016 CGA Interclub and Senior Interclub Championship Entry Form

## To: CGA Interclub Captains, Co-Captains, Golf Professionals and New Contacts:

The annual Carolinas Interclub competition is ready to accept entries. The Carolinas Interclub features CGA member clubs competing amongst neighboring clubs in individual and four-ball net competition. Last year, 79 teams competed in the regular Interclub Championship with **River Hills CC** (*Lake Wylie, SC*) defeating **Pinehurst CC #1-6** (*Pinehurst, NC*) by two points.

**NEW for 2016!** In addition to the current (Regular) Interclub, the CGA is introducing a <u>Senior Interclub</u> league using a similar but slightly modified format. Both competitions will run independently of each other. **Regular Interclub** team competition will continue to use **12** player teams playing concurrent "singles" and "four-ball" match play formats in each match. Minimum age is 18.

<u>Senior Interclub</u> teams will involve "four-ball" match play only with **8** players competing in a match for each team. Minimum age is 55.

In both competitions players are awarded "match points" and the team earning the most points wins the overall match. Both Regular and Senior Interclub players will use their twelve month Low Handicap Index (LI) to create an even playing field. Teams will pre-form in groups/pods of 4 or 6 and will play both home and away matches during the regular season (April – August). <u>Regular Interclub</u> matches are played on weekends while the <u>Senior Interclub</u> matches can be scheduled any day of the week. Pod winners and other qualifying teams from both competitions will advance to separate playoff formats (the <u>Regular Interclub</u> playoffs will continue to be single elimination while the <u>Senior Interclub</u> playoff format will be determined depending on the number of teams entered). Pinewild CC and the CGA will host the 2016 <u>Regular Interclub</u> "Final Four" in November. The <u>Senior Interclub</u> Championship site and format will be announced soon.

The Carolinas Interclub is a service of the Carolinas Golf Association and is open to any male member of a CGA member club in both North and South Carolina. Entry forms for both leagues are available on the CGA website under: <u>"Tournaments"</u> then <u>"Carolinas Interclub Season</u>". You can submit your team entry online or also submit entry forms and fees in the mail.

A pre-season Captain's meeting to review the Interclub format, match play rules, pairings, and how to use TPP (Tournament Pairing Program) will be held at the CGA headquarters in Southern Pines, NC, on **Thursday**, **March 3 (Time TBD).** Each **NEW** participating club and/or captain must attend. Participating teams will receive (via email) more information about the Captain's meeting as entries are received.

Groups will be made up of 4 or 6 teams and can be pre-formed. **PLEASE CONFIRM WITH THE OTHER CLUBS BEFORE LISTING THEIR NAMES ON THE ENTRY FORM AS PART OF YOUR GROUP.** Clubs that sign up individually will be assigned (as much as possible) to a group by the CGA at the regional Captains meeting. Participants will also be listed on the web as entries are received.

The entry deadline is March 1 (*April 1 for mountain clubs closed for the winter*). Entry fees are \$300 per team for <u>Regular Interclub</u> teams and \$200 for <u>Senior Interclub</u> teams and must be received by March 1, 2016 (*April 1 for mountain clubs*). The entry fee for clubs entering two teams in the <u>Regular Interclub</u> competition is \$250 per team. (Maximum of two teams per club in Regular Interclub).
