Subject: 2017 CGA Interclub (REGULAR and SENIOR) Championship Entry Forms

Entries for the annual Carolinas Interclub competition are now open. This Interclub competition features neighboring member clubs competing amongst each other in match play net competition. 75 teams competed in the 19th REGULAR Interclub Championship in 2016 while 45 teams battled it out for the inaugural SENIOR Interclub title.

Format:

- <u>REGULAR</u> Interclub team competition involves 12 players from each team playing "four-ball" match play. Minimum age is 18. Matches are played primarily on weekends.
- <u>SENIOR</u> Interclub team competition involves **8** players from each team playing "four-ball" match play. Minimum age is 55. Matches are played primarily on weekdays.
- Both leagues will play home and away matches during the regular season (April 1 August 13).
- Both leagues will use each player's 12 month LI (Low Index).
- A total of 6 (six) points will be available in each four-ball match (2 points for each side and 2 for the overall match). A team winning the majority of the available overall points will earn 3 "record" points towards their respective POD standings. Matches ending in a tie will result in 1 "record" point each.
- First and second place teams from each POD will advance to a single elimination playoff format
 for each league. A limited number of "wild card" playoff spots will also be awarded based on
 won/loss records and accumulated match points. The "Final Four" teams from each league will
 compete for their respective championship at pre-determined sites and dates hosted by the CGA.
 Both Championship sites and dates will be announced in February.

Captains Meeting:

A pre-season Captain's meeting to review; Interclub/Match play rules, pairings, etc., will be held **Tuesday March 7** in Southern Pines. Each **NEW** participating club and/or captain must attend. Participating teams will receive more information about the Captain's meeting as entries are received.

Entry Forms:

- Teams are encouraged to pre-form their own groups/pods. PLEASE CONFIRM WITH THE
 OTHER CLUBS BEFORE LISTING THEIR NAMES ON THE ENTRY FORM AS PART OF
 YOUR GROUP/POD. Clubs that sign up individually will be assigned (as much as possible) to a
 group by the CGA.
- Entry forms and fees must be submitted by mail. The entry deadline is March 1 (April 1 for mountain clubs closed for the winter). REGULAR Interclub entry fees are \$300 (\$250 per team if submitting two teams). The SENIOR Interclub entry fee is \$200 per team.

The Carolinas Interclub is a service of the Carolinas Golf Association and is open to any male member of a CGA member club in both North and South Carolina. Please contact one of the following if you have questions.
