# **CUSTOMS & TRADITIONS**

#### **Gate Hours**

The front gate to the Club property will open at **7:00** a.m. Participants staying on property will need to obtain a remote upon registration for access after **8:30** p.m.

#### Speed Limit

The Club has an old fashioned dirt road. As you wind through the grand old live oaks, under the Spanish moss, through the double plateau first and past the redan sixth and road seventh, please be aware that the Club's <u>speed limit is 20 mph</u>.

### Cell Phone & Data Devices

Cell Phone and Data Device use is *prohibited* on Club grounds. You may however use such devices in your car or in your bedrooms.

#### Dress

Golf dress, including soft spikes, is acceptable anywhere throughout the Club. Acceptable apparel includes shirts with collars that are not rounded and Bermuda shorts without "cargo" type pockets.

#### Clubhouse & Golf House

Please see legend. In the event of inclement weather, we will use the Golf House, Cart Barn and Clubhouse living room as shelter. Men are requested *not* to wear hats while in the Clubhouse.

#### Smoking

The entire Clubhouse, Golf House and all of the cottages are non smoking areas of the Club. You may enjoy a cigarette, pipe or cigar on the various porches and patios located off the Living Room, Library or the porches of the cottages. Smoking is also permitted on the golf course.
