Carolinas Interclub Conducted by the Carolinas Golf Association



2023 CGA Interclub (REGULAR, SENIOR & SUPER SENIOR) Entry Information

Entries for the annual Carolinas Interclub competition are now open. This competition features neighboring member clubs competing amongst each other in match play net competition. 92 teams competed in the 25th REGULAR Interclub Season in 2022 while 139 teams battled it out for the 7th SENIOR Interclub title. 2023 will feature the 1st Super Senior Interclub Season!

FORMAT:

- REGULAR Interclub team competition involves 8 players from each team competing in "Four-Ball" match play format. Minimum age is 18. Matches are played primarily on weekends.
- SENIOR & SUPER SENIOR Interclub team competition involves 8 players from each team competing in "Four-Ball" match play format. Minimum age is 55 for Senior & 65 for Super Senior. Matches are played primarily on weekdays (Note clubs with teams in the Senior AND Super Senior may host home matches on the same day).
- Both leagues play home and away (6 total) matches during the regular season (March to Mid-July).
- Players in each league compete with 85% of their 12-Month Low Handicap Index (updated weekly every Monday).
- Each of the 4 Four-Ball matches is worth 18 match points (1 point per hole). 2 additional points are awarded to each Four-Ball winning team. A total of 80 match points is available in each Team Match.

 The team winning the majority (40½) of points will earn a win in their POD. Each POD win is worth 2 points in the standings. A (40/40) tie is worth 1 point for each team. Accumulated match points are recorded and used to break ties within POD standings and for Playoff seeding. Players should strive to win all available points.
- Playoffs begin the first week of August and are single elimination. 1st and 2nd place teams from each four team POD will earn a playoff spot. A 3rd team is invited from Pods with six teams. Teams with a .500 win/loss record or better will also make the playoffs.
- The "Final Four" teams from each league will compete for their respective championship at pre-determined sites and dates hosted by the CGA. Both "Final Four" sites and dates will be announced in February.

CAPTAINS MEETINGS:

Pre-season Captains meetings to review Interclub/Match play rules, pairings, etc., will be held <u>on Zoom.</u> Each participating club captain MUST ATTEND ONE MEETING. We ask that captains attend based on the preferred regions to help form PODs. Team captains that cannot attend their regional meeting date may join any other meeting if there is room available. Participating teams will receive more information about the Captain's meeting as entries are received. Meeting dates are as follows:

March 8th @ 5:30 - 7:30pm (Charlotte, Triad & Upstate/Western South Carolina area captains preferred)

March 9th @ 5:30 - 7:30pm (Pinehurst, Research Triangle & Triad area captains preferred)

March 15th @ 5:30 - 7:30 pm (Coastal area captains preferred)

March 16th @ 5:30 - 7:30pm (Golf Genius Manual Review & makeup session

ENTRY INFORMATION:

- Teams pre-form their own PODS. PLEASE CONFIRM WITH THE OTHER CLUBS BEFORE LISTING THEIR NAMES ON THE ENTRY FORM AS PART OF YOUR POD. Individual teams will be assigned to a POD by the CGA.
- Each team must register online <u>HERE</u>. Please read all directions during online registration carefully. The entry deadline <u>is March 3rd at 11:59 pm (April 1 for mountain clubs closed for the winter)</u>. Entry fee is \$300 per team. A Credit Card can be used when submitting an entry form. A check can also be mailed to the CGA
- NOTE: EACH INTERCLUB TEAM MUST SUBMIT ONE Entry Form per TEAM.
- The Carolinas Interclub is a service of the Carolinas Golf Association and is open to any male member of a CGA member club in both North and South Carolina. Please contact one of the following if you have questions.
