2024 CGA Interclub (REGULAR, SENIOR & SUPER SENIOR) Entry Information

Entries for the annual Carolinas Interclub competition are <u>OPEN</u> to all CGA member clubs. Registration will <u>close February 9th</u> <u>@ 11:59pm.</u> This competition features neighboring CGA member clubs competing amongst each other in net match play competition. 310 teams competed across three age divisions in 2023, which featured the inaugural season for Super Senior Interclub and 80 teams!

FORMAT:

- REGULAR Interclub team competition involves 8 players from each team competing in "Four-Ball" match play format. Minimum age is 18. Matches are played primarily on weekends but may be played on weekdays.
- SENIOR & SUPER SENIOR Interclub team competition involves 8 players from each team competing in "Four-Ball" match play format. Minimum age is 55 for Senior & 65 for Super Senior. Matches are played primarily on weekdays (Note-It's advised matches are NOT played on Mondays due to weekly handicap updates).
- Each team plays 3 home and 3 away (6 total) matches during the regular season (March 1 to July 21)
- Pairings are based on each player's Low Handicap Index™ (Low H.I.)
- Players play to 85% of their Course Handicap, based on their Low H.I. (updated each Monday)
- Each of the 4 Four-Ball matches is worth 20 match points (1 point per hole = 18). 2 additional points are awarded to each Four-Ball winning team (or split if tied). A total of 80 match points is available in each Team Match.

 The team winning the majority (40½) of points will earn a win in their POD. Match points accumulate throughout the regular season, and are used for tie breaking for pod standings and playoff spots.
- NEW for 2024 Playoffs begin July 29. The top 64 teams in EACH division qualify. Pod winners automatically qualify and 2nd place teams in 5 and 6 team pods will also earn a playoff spot. Any remaining spots will be determined by record and accumulated match points.
- NEW for 2024 The Final Four for all three divisions will be hosted simultaneously by the CGA at a TBA site/dates.

CAPTAINS MEETINGS:

Pre-season Captains meetings to review Interclub/Match play rules, pairings, etc., will be held <u>on Zoom.</u> NEW captains are required to attend, and returning captains are strongly encouraged to attend. We ask that captains attend based on the preferred regions to help form PODs.

Team captains that cannot attend their regional meeting date may attend another. Participating teams will receive more information about the Captain's meeting as entries are received. Meeting dates are as follows:

February 13th @ 5:30 - 7:30pm (Charlotte, Triad & Upstate/Western South Carolina area captains preferred)

February 15th @ 5:30 - 7:30pm (Pinehurst, Research Triangle & Triad area captains preferred)

February 19th @ 5:30 - 7:30 pm (Coastal area captains preferred)
February 21st @ 5:30 - 7:30pm (Golf Genius Manual Review & makeup session)

ENTRY INFORMATION:

- Teams pre-form their own PODS. PLEASE CONFIRM WITH THE OTHER CLUBS BEFORE LISTING THEIR NAMES ON THE ENTRY FORM AS PART OF YOUR POD. Individual teams will be assigned to a POD by the CGA.
- Each team must register online <u>HERE</u>. Please read all directions during online registration carefully. The **entry deadline is February 9th at 11:59 pm** (*April 1 for mountain clubs closed for the winter*). Entry fee is \$300 per team. A Credit Card can be used when submitting an entry form. A check can also be mailed to the CGA
- NOTE: EACH INTERCLUB TEAM MUST SUBMIT ONE Entry Form per TEAM.
