# 2025 CAROLINAS INTERCLUB ENTRY INFORMATION

Entries for the annual Carolinas Interclub competition <u>OPENS Monday, December 9 @ 9:00am</u> to all CGA member clubs. Registration will <u>CLOSE Sunday, February9@11:59pm.</u> This competition features neighboring CGA member clubs competing amongst each other in Net Four-Ball Match Play competition. 332 teams competed across three age divisions in 2024, representing 136 CGA Member Clubs and over 5,100 golfers!

## **FORMAT:**

- Interclub team competition involves 8 players from each team competing in "Four-Ball" match play format. There are 3 age divisions:
  - o <u>Carolinas Division</u> minimum age is 18 years old (matches primarily on weekends but can be on weekdays)
  - o Senior Division minimum age is 55 years old (matches primarily on weekdays but can be on weekends)
  - o Super Senior Division minimum age is 65 years old (matches primarily on weekdays but can be on weekends)
  - Teams play 6 Regular Season matches; 3 Home and 3 Away (2025 Regular Season: March 1 July 20)
- Pairings are based on each player's 12-month Low Handicap Index™ (Low H.I.) Handicaps updated each Monday
- Players compete to 85% of the difference in the Unrounded Course Handicaps from the player with the lowest Playing Handicap in each foursome, based on their Low H.I.
- Each of the 4, Four-Ball matches are worth 20 match points (1 point per hole = 18). 2 additional points are awarded to each Four-Ball winning team (or split if tied). A total of 80 match points is available in each Team Match. The team winning the majority ( $40\frac{1}{2}$ ) of points will earn a win in their POD. Match points accumulate throughout the regular season, and are used for tie breaking for pod standings and playoff standings.
- Playoffs begin Monday, July 28. The top 64 teams in EACH division qualify. Pod winners automatically qualify and 2nd place teams in 5 and 6 team pods also automatically qualify. Any remaining spots will be determined by Regular Season record and accumulated match points.

### **CAPTAINS MEETINGS:**

Pre-season Captains meetings to review Interclub/Match play rules, Pods & Golf Genius, will be held <u>on Zoom.</u> NEW captains are required to attend, and returning captains are strongly encouraged to attend. We ask that captains choose their preferred date when registering.

Team captains that cannot attend a pre-season meeting may request a recording. Participating teams will receive more information about the Captain's meeting as entries are received. Meeting dates are as follows and start @ 5:30pm: Tuesday, February 11

## **ENTRY INFORMATION:**

- Teams pre-form their own PODS. PLEASE CONFIRM WITH THE OTHER CLUBS BEFORE LISTING THEIR NAMES ON THE ENTRY FORM AS PART OF YOUR POD. Individual teams will be assigned to a POD by the CGA.
- Each team must register online <u>HERE</u>. Please read all directions during online registration carefully. The **entry deadline is**February 9th at 11:59 pm (April 1 for mountain clubs closed for the winter). Entry fee is \$300 per team. A Credit Card can be used when submitting an entry form. A check can also be mailed to the CGA
- NOTE: EACH INTERCLUB CLUB MUST SUBMIT AN ENTRY FORM ONLINE
