

# 47th Father-Son Championship of the Carolinas Golf Association

July 26, 2013 Pinehurst, NC Area Courses

Entries Open: June 2 Entry Fee: \*\$110.00 Entries Close: July 16

#### ELIGIBILITY

Entry is open to any team comprised of a father and son, stepfather and stepson, in-laws or grandfather and grandson. At least one member of each team must be a legal resident of one of the Carolinas, be a member in good standing of a club which is a member of the Carolinas Golf Association (CGA), have a current USGA handicap index® at a CGA member club or is a golf professional employed at a CGA member club. A team is eligible if one partner is an amateur member of a CGA member club or if one partner is an amateur member of a CGA member club. Pro-Pro teams are NOT eligible. Entries are subject to rejection at any time, including during the event, by the CGA or the host club. The reason for rejection may include unbecoming conduct. The minimum age for entry is eight years as of the tournament date. For complete residency and eligibility requirements, refer to the CGA Tournament Manual at www.carolinasgolf.org.

#### ENTRIES

All teams must complete an official entry form. Online entry applications may be completed at www.carolinasgolf.org. Fax. e-mail. telephone. incomplete, illegible, or entries received before the opening date and after the closing date, are not accepted.

Entries are accumulated for the entire open/close window. The final field is comprised of the 450 lowest team handicap indexes (as computed under the "FORMAT" section). Alternate teams are ranked according to team handicap index. Course assignment and starting times are sent to the first player listed on this form.

Amateur division course assignment and flight is determined by team handicap index. Super Senior, Open (Pro-Am) and 13 & Under divisions are assigned to courses. Therefore, requests for courses and starting times are not granted. The CGA is not responsible for errors or delays by any mail courier or internet service provider. Entries are only accepted between the open and close dates as stated above. Confirmation of acceptance and tournament information is sent to the <u>first</u> player listed on this form when their status has been determined. Status may be checked at www.carolinasgolf.org. The entry fee must be paid by each team and must accompany this form. <u>Only one entry fee per check.</u> Make check payable to the Carolinas Golf Association. Detach, sign and mail the entry form with the \$110 entry fee to the CGA, PO Box 319, West End, NC 27376. A team whose check is returned for insufficient funds may be disqualified indefinitely from CGA competitions. Teams who "Did Not Show" (DNS) or "No Card" (NC) are suspended from next year's Carolinas Father-Son Championship.

#### REFUND POLICY

Entry fee refund policy schedule:

Open Date to Close Date: Full refund minus \$25.00 administrative fee if entry accepted into championship.

Day after Close Date to Day Prior to Championship Date: Full refund minus \$50.00 administrative fee refunded regardless of reason if entry accepted into championship.

Withdraw on Championship Date: No refund for any reason. Alternates not gaining entry into the tournament receive a full refund.

#### <u>RULES</u>

USGA Rules of Golf govern play. Questions will be decided by the on-site Rules Committee whose decision will be final. Notice to Players and local rules are posted at host club and distributed at the starting tee(s). The CGA reserves the right to alter the conditions or schedules as stated, including alteration of the stipulated round(s) at any time during the championship including sectional qualifying. The competition is closed when the championship trophy has been presented. Special requests for starting times or pairings are not granted.

#### COURSE FEES; GOLF CARTS; CADDIES; SPECTATORS

<u>Championship round cart and range fees are included in the entry fee.</u> Cart use is mandatory during the championship round.

Cart rental and use is mandatory for practice rounds.

Caddies are allowed for championship rounds. A player may provide his own caddie. Caddies will not be available at host club.

Caddie/Spectator Cart Policy: During the play of a hole, either the player or his caddie may ride in a golf cart but not both at the same time. Spectators are not allowed to ride in a player's golf cart at any time. Club owned spectator carts are not allowed except as provided in the CGA Tournament Manual.

#### **FORMAT**

Each team plays alternate shot except that both team members hit from each tee and then select the ball to be played (modified alternate shot). A team must complete the hole with the ball selected.

Teams select the division in which to compete if eligible:

**Amateur Division**: Team comprised of two amateurs. Overall champions are determined from this division. Gross scores only. Flights and course assignments are determined by ^team handicap index. Both team members play the same yardage.

13 & Under Division: Team comprised of two amateurs. One amateur must be between the ages of 8 to 13 years old. 13 & Under team member plays a shorter yardage. Gross scores only. A trophy and merchandise is awarded to the overall winner. A 13 and under team may choose to compete in the Amateur Division but both team members must play from the same yardage.

**Super Senior Division**: Team comprised of two amateurs. One amateur must be at least 65 years old. 65 and over team member plays a shorter yardage. Gross scores only.

**Open (Pro-Am) Division**: Team comprised of one golf professional and one amateur (or an amateur awaiting reinstatement "A/R"). Open division competes at gross and net. Net scores are calculated using 40% of the amateur partners' course handicap. Golf professionals play at scratch handicap.

 $^{ ext{Team}}$  handicap index is computed by adding 2/3 of the lower handicap index to 1/3 of the higher handicap index.

Approximate Yardage (\*Note: yardage is subject to change):
Amateur Division Championship Site=6500 yards
Amateur Division (all other sites)=6000-6200 yards
Open Division: Professionals=6500 yards; Amateurs=6000-6200 yards
13 & Under Contestants=5600 yards
Super Senior Contestants=5600 yards

Note: CGA reserves the right to adjust the format dependent upon the number of entries.

#### **PRIZES**

Merchandise is distributed to top teams in each amateur division and to overall amateur champions. Open division merchandise is distributed based on the size of open field. Ties for prizes are split except for the overall amateur division and the open division, which is determined by an on-course playoff.

#### **EXEMPTIONS**

There are no exemptions for this championship.

#### Friday, July 26

Championship round. 18 holes of modified alternate shot.
