

# 18th North Carolina Four-Ball Championship of the Carolinas Golf Association

October 4-6, 2013 River Run Country Club, Davidson, NC

Entries Open: August 11 Entry Fee: \$170.00 Entries Close: September 24

#### ELIGIBILITY

Entry is open to any male amateur golfer who has reached his 13<sup>th</sup> birthday by October 4, 2013, is a legal resident of North Carolina, is a member in good standing of a club which is a member of the Carolinas Golf Association (CGA) and has a current USGA Handicap Index® at a CGA member club. Entries are subject to rejection at any time, including during the event, by the CGA or the host club. The reason for rejection may include unbecoming conduct or cell phone use during a stipulated round. All players must conform to the "USGA Rules of Amateur Status" as specified in "The Rules of Golf". For complete residency and eligibility requirements, refer to the CGA Tournament Manual at the CGA website (www.carolinasgolf.org). Championship field size: 72 teams.

#### **ENTRIES**

All teams, including those exempt, must complete an official entry form. Online entry applications may be completed at www.carolinasgolf.org. Fax, e-mail, telephone, incomplete, illegible entries, or entries received before the opening date or after the closing date, are not accepted.

Entries are accumulated for the entire open/close window. Exempt teams are accepted at time of entry. The remainder of the field is selected after entries close with the lowest team handicap indexes. Alternates are ranked according to team handicap index.

The CGA is not responsible for errors or delays by any mail courier or internet service provider. Entries are only accepted between the open and close dates as stated above. Confirmation of acceptance and tournament information is sent to the <u>first</u> player listed on this form when their status has been determined. Status may be checked at www.carolinasgolf.org. The entry fee must be paid by each team and must accompany this form. <u>Only one entry fee per check</u>. Make check payable to the Carolinas Golf Association. Detach, sign and mail the entry form with the \$170 entry fee to the CGA, PO Box 319, West End, NC 27376. A team whose check is returned for insufficient funds may be disqualified indefinitely from CGA competitions. Teams who "Did Not Show" (DNS) or "No Card" (NC) are suspended from next year's North Carolina Four-Ball Championship.

#### **REFUND POLICY**

Entry fee refund policy schedule:

Open Date to Close Date: Full refund minus \$25.00 administrative fee if entry accepted into championship.

Day after Close Date to Day Prior to Championship Date: Full refund minus \$50.00 administrative fee refunded regardless of reason if entry accepted into championship.

Withdraw on Championship Date: No refund for any reason.

Alternates not gaining entry into the tournament receive a full refund.

#### RULES

USGA Rules of Golf govern play. Questions will be decided by the on-site Rules Committee whose decision will be final. Notice to Players and local rules are posted at host club and distributed at the starting tee(s). The CGA reserves the right to alter the conditions or schedules as stated, including alteration of the stipulated round(s) at any time during the championship including sectional qualifying. The competition is closed when the championship trophy has been presented. Special requests for starting times or pairings are not granted.

# COURSE FEES; GOLF CARTS; CADDIES; SPECTATORS

**New for 2013:** Daily range fees are included in the entry fee. Players that opt to walk during championship rounds will not owe any other fees to the host club. Players that opt to use a golf cart must pay the appropriate cart fee prior to each championship round.

Practice Rounds: Cart rental is mandatory for practice rounds. Competitors have the option to either walk or use a golf cart during championship rounds.

Caddies: Caddies are allowed for championship rounds. A player may provide his own caddie. Caddies will not be available at host club.

Caddie/Spectator Cart Policy: During the play of a hole, either the player or his caddie may ride in a golf cart but not both at the same time. Spectators are not allowed to ride in a player's golf cart at any time. Club owned spectator carts are not allowed except as provided in the CGA Tournament Manual.

#### <u>FORMAT</u>

The championship format is 54 holes of four-ball stroke play. After 36 holes, the field is cut to the low 30 scores and ties. A tie for the overall championship is decided by an on-course playoff.

#### PRIZES

Champions receive trophies and merchandise from host club. Merchandise prizes are awarded to the top 20 finishers at the championship.

#### **EXEMPTIONS**

- 1. Champions of the North Carolina Four-Ball Championship since 2003.
- Teams that finished 20th or better at the 2012 North Carolina Four-Ball Championship.
- One exemption for championship host club. Entry must be received by entry closing date.

\*Exempt team members must compete on the same team or with another exempt player.

First round. 18 holes of four-ball stroke play.

### Saturday, October 5

Second round. 18 holes of four-ball stroke play. Field cut to low 30 scores and ties for final round.

#### Sunday, October 6

Final round. 18 holes of four-ball stroke play.
