

6th North Carolina Super Senior Championship of the Carolinas Golf Association

September 24-25, 2013

ELIGIBILITY

Entry is open to any male amateur golfer who has reached his <u>65th</u> birthday by September 24, 2013, is a legal resident of North Carolina, is a member in good standing of a club which is a member of the Carolinas Golf Association (CGA) and has a current USGA Handicap Index® at a CGA member club that does not exceed <u>15.4</u>. Entries are subject to rejection at any time, including during the event, by the CGA or the host club. The reason for rejection may include unbecoming conduct. All players must conform to the "USGA Rules of Amateur Status" as specified in "The Rules of Golf". For complete residency and eligibility requirements, refer to the CGA Tournament Manual at the CGA website (www.carolinasgolf.org). Championship Field Size: 96

ENTRIES AND ALTERNATES

All players, including those exempt, must complete an official entry form. Online entry applications may be completed at www.carolinasgolf.org. Fax, email, telephone, incomplete and illegible entries received before the opening date and after the closing date are not accepted. Exempt players are accepted at time of entry. Non-exempt entries are accumulated for the entire open/close window. The final field is comprised of exempt players and players with lowest handicap indexes. Alternates are ranked according to handicap index. The CGA is not responsible for errors or delays by any mail courier or Internet service provider. Entries are only accepted between the open and close dates as stated above. Confirmation of acceptance is sent to players when their status is determined. Status may be checked at www.carolinasgolf.org. The entry fee must be paid by each player and must accompany this form. Only one entry fee per check. Make check payable to the Carolinas Golf Association. Detach, sign and mail the entry form with the \$130 entry fee to the CGA, PO Box 319, West End, NC 27376. A player whose check is returned for insufficient funds may be disqualified indefinitely from CGA competitions. Players who "Did Not Show" (DNS) or "No Card" (NC) are suspended from next year's North Carolina Super Senior Championship.

REFUND POLICY

Entry fee refund policy schedule:

Open Date to Close Date: Full refund minus \$25.00 administrative fee if entry accepted into championship.

Day after Close Date to Day Prior to Championship Date: Full refund minus \$50.00 administrative fee refunded regardless of reason if entry accepted into championship.

Withdraw on Championship Date: No refund for any reason.

Alternates not gaining entry into the tournament receive a full refund.

RULES

USGA Rules of Golf govern play. Questions will be decided by the on-site Rules Committee whose decision will be final. Notice to Players and local rules are posted at host club and distributed at the starting tee(s). The CGA reserves the right to alter the conditions or schedules as stated, including alteration of the stipulated round(s) at any time during the championship including sectional qualifying. The competition is closed when the championship trophy has been presented. Special requests for starting times or pairings are not granted. Dress code: No cut-off shorts or denim, no shorts shorter than four inches above the knees, no tank tops or t-shirts, and all shirts must have either a collar or sleeves.

COURSE FEES; GOLF CARTS; CADDIES; SPECTATORS

Daily cart/range fees and final round lunch are included in the entry fee

Cart rental is <u>mandatory</u> for practice rounds. Competitors must use a cart during championship rounds.

Caddies are allowed for championship rounds. A player may provide his own caddie. Caddies will not be available at host club.

Caddie/Spectator Cart Policy: Since players are required to use a golf cart at this event, caddies are required to walk. Spectators are not allowed to ride in a player's golf cart at any time. Club owned spectator carts are not allowed except as provided in the CGA Tournament Manual.

FORMAT

The championship is 36 holes of stroke play.

PRIZES

Champion receives a trophy and merchandise. Merchandise will be awarded to the top 30 finishers based upon a full-field.

Entries Close: September 10

EXEMPTIONS

Players in the following categories are exempt if otherwise eligible. A complete list of exempt players is available on the CGA website.

- 1. All former champions of the Carolinas Senior Amateur Championship.
- All former champions of the North Carolina Senior Amateur Championship.
 All former individual Carolinas Golf Association champions.
- 4 All former champions of the North Carolina Super Senior Championship

5. Players who finished 30th or better at the 2012 North Carolina Super Senior Championship.

6. Players who finished 30th or better at the 2012 Carolinas Senior Championship.

7. Players who finished 30th or better at the 2013 Carolinas Super Senior. 8. Players who finished 30th or better at the 2013 North Carolina Senior Amateur.

9. Players ranked in the top 50 of the Carolinas Senior Men's Amateur Rankings as of the opening date.

10. 2012 USGA Championship qualifiers who advanced to match play at the amateur championships, finished top-100 at the U.S. Senior Open or advanced to the U.S. Open Championship proper.

11. One exemption for championship host club. Entry must be received by entry closing date.

12. Special exemption bestowed by the CGA.
