

3rd Net Amateur Championship of the Carolinas Golf Association

November 23-24, 2013

Pinehurst Resort & Country Club (Course No. 5), Pinehurst, NC

Entries Open: September 29 Entry Fee: \$150.00 **Entries Close: November 12**

(Cart & Range Fees and Saturday Social Included)

ELIGIBILITY

Entry is open to any amateur golfer who has reached his or her 18th birthday by November 23, 2013, is a legal resident of North Carolina or South Carolina, is a member in good standing of a club which is a member of the Carolinas Golf Association (CGA) and has a current USGA Handicap Index® at a CGA member club. Entries are subject to rejection at any time, including during the event, by the CGA or the host club. The reason for rejection may include unbecoming conduct. All players must conform to the "USGA Rules of Amateur Status" as specified in "The Rules of Golf". For complete residency and eligibility requirements, refer to the CGA Tournament Manual at the CGA website (www.carolinasgolf.org). Field size=104 players.

ENTRIES AND ALTERNATES

All players must complete an official entry form. Online entry applications may be completed at www.carolinasgolf.org. Fax, e-mail, telephone, incomplete and illegible entries received before the opening date and after the closing date are not accepted.

Exempt players are accepted at time of entry (see "Exemptions").

The first 99 non-exempt entries are accepted on a first come, first served basis regardless of gender according to date and time entry is received by the CGA. Alternates are ranked in order which entries are received.

The CGA is not responsible for errors or delays by any mail courier or Internet service provider. Entries are only accepted between the open and close dates as stated above. Confirmation of acceptance is sent to players when their status is determined. Status may be checked at www.carolinasgolf.org. The entry fee must be paid by each player and must accompany this form. Only one entry fee per check. Make check payable to the Carolinas Golf Association. Detach, sign and mail the entry form with the \$150 entry fee to the CGA, PO Box 319, West End, NC 27376. A player whose check is returned for insufficient funds may be disqualified indefinitely from CGA competitions. Players who "Did Not Show" (DNS) or "No Card" (NC) are suspended from next year's Carolinas Net Amateur Championship.

REFUND POLICY

Entry fee refund policy schedule:

Open Date to Close Date: Full refund minus \$25.00 administrative fee if entry accepted into championship.

Day after Close Date to Day Prior to Championship Date: Full refund minus \$50.00 administrative fee refunded regardless of reason if entry accepted into championship

Withdraw on Championship Date: No refund for any reason.

Alternates not gaining entry into the tournament receive a full refund.

USGA Rules of Golf govern play. Questions will be decided by the on-site Rules Committee whose decision will be final. Notice to Players and local rules are posted at host club and distributed at the starting tee(s). The CGA reserves the right to alter the conditions or schedules as stated, including alteration of the stipulated round(s) at any time during the championship. The competition is closed when the championship trophy has been presented. Special requests for starting times or pairings are not granted. Dress code: No cut-off shorts or denim, no shorts shorter than four inches above the knees, no tank tops or tshirts, and all shirts must have either a collar or sleeves.

COURSE FEES; GOLF CARTS; CADDIES; SPECTATORS

Daily cart/range fees and Saturday social are included in the entry fee.

Cart rental is mandatory for practice rounds. Competitors must use a cart during championship rounds.

Caddies are allowed for championship rounds. A player may provide his own caddie. Caddies will not be available at host club.

Caddie/Spectator Cart Policy: During the play of a hole, either the player or his caddie may ride in a golf cart but not both at the same time. Spectators are not allowed to ride in a player's golf cart at any time. Club owned spectator carts are not allowed except as provided in the CGA Tournament Manual.

FORMAT

The championship is 36 holes of net stroke play using 100% Course Handicap. Net Score is calculated by subtracting Course Handicap from Gross Score. Players select the division in which to compete if eligible:

Men (age 18+); Senior Men (age 55+); Women (age 18+); Senior Women (age

Men age 55+ have the option to compete in the Men's division. Women age 50+ have the option to compete in the Women's division.

Players are assigned into flights within divisions by net score following the first

HANDICAP AND "KNOCKOUT RULE"

USGA Handicap Index as of the November 15, 2013 revision will be used to determine a player's Course Handicap.

The CGA may, in an exceptional individual case, modify a player's Course Handicap before or between rounds of the competition.

A player is disqualified if his net score beats the course rating by eight or more strokes and beats the next best net score in their division by four or more strokes for BOTH championship rounds.

PRIZES AND PLAYOFFS

Overall champion in each division receives a trophy and merchandise. Merchandise will be awarded to the top finishers in each flight based upon the number of entrants.

A tie for the overall champion in each division is determined by an on-course three hole playoff using 1/6 course handicap rounded to the nearest whole number. If a tie remains then co-champions will be declared

All other ties are broken on the score card using the USGA recommended method.

EXEMPTIONS

Players in the following categories are exempt if otherwise eligible.

- 1. 2012 Carolinas Net Amateur Men's Division Champion. (Stephen Shad, Jr.)
- 2. 2012 Carolinas Net Amateur Women's Division Champion. (Jamie Fisher)
- 3. 2012 Carolinas Net Amateur Senior Men's Division Champion. (Jim Steed)
- 4. 2012 Carolinas Net Amateur Senior Women's Division Champion. (Mary Chamberlin and Charlotte Harvey)
