All competitors must register on line.

ELIGIBILITY

Entry is open to any male amateur golfer who has not reached his 19th birthday by June 20, 2014, who has not started college, is a legal resident of North Carolina, is a member in good standing of a club which is a member of the Carolinas Golf Association (CGA) and has a current USGA Handicap Index® at a CGA member club that does not exceed 18.3. Entries are subject to rejection at any time, including during the event, by the CGA or the host club. The reason for rejection may include unbecoming conduct or cell phone use during a stipulated round. All players must conform to the "USGA Rules of Amateur Status" as specified in "The Rules of Golf". For complete residency and elipibility requirements, refer to the CGA Tournament Manual at the CGA website, (www.carolinasgolf.org). Championship field size=144 players

ENTRY FEES (NEW)

Sectional Qualifying Entry Fee: \$50.00

ENTRIES AND ONLINE REGISTRATION (NEW)

Successful Qualifier Championship Entry Fee: \$50.00 (Fee is charged automatically to the credit card used for sectional qualifying registration).

Exempt Player Entry Fee: \$100.00

All players, including those exempt, must register online at www.carolinasgolf.org. Mail-in applications are no longer accepted for this event. Fax, mail, e-mail, telephone, incomplete, illegible, or entries received before the opening date and after the closing date, are not accepted.

Exempt Players: Accepted into the championship proper at time of entry. **Non-exempt Players:** Gain entry into the championship proper through sectional qualifying (see "Exemptions from Sectional Qualifying" and "Sectional Qualifying and Alternates" sections).

The CGA is not responsible for errors or delays by any internet service provider. Entries are only accepted between the open and close dates as stated above. Confirmation of acceptance is sent to players when their status is determined. Status may be checked at www.carolinasgolf.org. The appropriate entry fee must be paid by each player at time of registration. Players who "Did Not Show" (DNS) or "No Card" (NC) are suspended from next year's NC Junior Boys' Championship.

REFUND POLICY (NEW)

Entry fee refund policy schedule:

Open Date to Day Prior to Championship or Qualifying Date: Full refund minus \$30.00 administrative fee regardless of reason if entry accepted into championship or sectional qualifier.

Withdraw on Championship or Qualifying Date; No-Shows: No refund for any reason.

Alternates: Full refund if player does not gain entry into a qualifying site.

*Note: Refund policy and schedule applies to each entry fee stage. Example: Player pays \$50.00 entry fee to qualify. Player is successful in qualifying and is automatically charged the \$50.00 championship entry fee balance due to their credit card. Player withdraws from the championship proper on the day prior to the first round. Player receives a refund of \$20.00 (\$50.00 championship entry fee balance-\$30.00 admin fee).

RULES

USGA Rules of Golf govern play. Questions will be decided by the on-site Rules Committee whose decision will be final. Notice to Players and local rules are posted at host club and distributed at the starting tee(s). The CGA reserves the right to alter the conditions or schedules as stated, including alteration of the stipulated round(s) at any time during the championship. The competition is closed when the championship trophy has been presented. Special requests for starting times or pairings are not granted.

FORMAT

The championship format is match play with an 18 hole of stroke play qualifier (Tuesday, June 17th) to determine the seeding for match play. The top 63 boys from the stroke play qualifier will advance to match play. Defending champion Austin Inman of Wilmington, NC will be seeded number one for match play. Once a player loses a match, they are eliminated from the tournament.

YARDAGES

Boys will compete at approximately 6,435 yards, par 72.

<u>AGE DIVISIONS</u>

Boys will compete in one division. There are no age divisions.

PRIZES

Trophies are awarded to the champion, runner-up, semifinalists, quarterfinalists, and the medalist.

TEAM MATCHES

Champion will be invited to represent the CGA in the Carolinas-Virginias Junior Team Matches at River Landing CC in Wallace, NC on August 16-17, 2014

EXEMPTIONS

- 9. Top 10 from Jimmy Anderson Junior on April 5-6, 2014.
- 10. Top 10 from TYGA NC High School Invitational on April 14, 2014.
- 11. Top 5 from TYGA One Day Event on April 26, 2014
- 12. Top 5 from TYGA One Day Event on May 17, 2014.
- 13. Top 5 from 2013 NC Middle School Championship
- 14. All those who qualify and compete in 2014 NC Men's Amateur.

SECTIONAL QUALIFYING

Those not included in the above categories have the opportunity to qualify on June 12th at Cardinal CC in Pine Level, NC or on June 16th at Cedarbrook CC in Elkin, NC. A minimum of ten spots will be available at each site. The final qualifying numbers will be determined after entries have closed. Those players who are successful in qualifying on June 12th and June 16th will be charged \$50.00 (Fee is charged automatically to the credit card used for sectional qualifying registration).
