must call the golf shop to schedule a practice round starting time. Please identify yourself as a Carolinas

Junior Girls Championship participant when calling. The practice round will be \$25.00 (walking).

Starting times: Starting times for the first round will be available by July 22, 2014 after 5:00pm through the

carolinasgolf.org web site or by calling the CGA office.

Yardages: Juniors: 6,000 yards

Sub juniors: 5,200 yards

Prizes: Trophies will be awarded to the overall champion, first, second and third places in each flight.

Caddies: Players must walk at all times, but may use a caddie. Caddie must be 18 years of age or younger, no

exceptions. Caddies must walk at all times.

Measuring devices: Measuring devices that only measure distance may be used during the championship.

Spectator carts: Spectator carts will be available to rent for \$25.00 per cart. All carts are restricted to the cart path.
