Monday, June 23. Contestants must call the golf shop to schedule a practice round starting time. Please

identify yourself as a North Carolina Junior participant when calling.

Starting times: Qualifying round starting times will be available through the CGA office and/or the carolinasgolf.org web

site on June 18 after 5:00pm.

Yardages: Approx. 5,765 yards, par 72 (Gold tees except blue tee on #4 and red tee on #5)

medalist.

Caddies: Players must walk at all times, but may use a caddie.

Caddy must be 18 years of age or younger, no exceptions.

Caddies must walk at all times as well.

Bentwinds CC does allow the use of push carts.

Push carts Players may use a push cart during the tournament.

Measuring Devices Distance measuring devices will be allowed. Note that if a smart phone or tablet is used as a distance

measuring device, the device must not contain apps that would render it non-conforming such as a

compass or level app.

Spectator carts: Spectator carts will be available to rent at a rate of \$25 per cart. Carts must remain on path at all times.

Method of payments: Starmount Forest CC accepts cash, MasterCard and Visa will be accepted for golf shop, food purchases

and spectator cart rentals.

Dress code: No metal or ceramic spikes.

Hats/visors must be worn with brim forward and must be removed while indoors. Collared shirts or mock turtlenecks must be worn and tucked in at all times.

Women's fashion shirts without a collar must have sleeves.

Women's fashion shirts must not rise above the belt line at anytime during the golf swing.

Shorts must be no more than 5" above the knee.

Player Registration: All players must register at Starmount Forest CC on Monday, June 23 from 1:00 pm - 5:30 pm.

Junior Teams: The girls champion will be invited to represent the Carolinas in the Mid-Atlantic Challenge at the Clubs at

Olde Mill in Laurel Fork, VA on July 26-27, 2014.

Rankings: This is a girls' junior rankings event that has been assigned a multiplier of 7.

Parent policy: Parents are encouraged to follow their child. We do ask that all parents remain on the cart path (roughs if

no cart paths), unless assisting with the search for a ball.

Withdraws: If you cannot compete in this championship, you must withdraw from the event by contacting the CGA

office at 910-673-1000 prior to round 1. If you do not withdraw properly, you are considered a "no show"

and you will be suspended from the 2015 NC Junior Girls' Championship.
