Format:	Junior division: 36-holes of individual stroke play. Players will be flighted after the first round. Sub junior division: 18-holes of individual stroke play (9 holes each day).		
Course:	The Ridgewood and Tall Pines nines will be used for the tournament course.		
Practice round:	A practice round will be available at Columbia CC on Monday, July 30, 2014. Contestants must call the golf shop to schedule a practice round starting time. Please identify yourself as a Twin States participant when calling. Players may call for practice round starting times beginning June 16, 2014 .		
Starting times:	Starting times will be available on Sunday, June 24 after 12pm through the carolinasgolf.org web site or by calling the CGA office.

Caddies:	Players must walk at all times, but may use a caddie. Caddie must be <u>18 years of age or younger</u> , no exceptions . Caddies must walk at all times. Players may use push carts.		
Push carts:	Players will be allowed to use push carts at Columbia CC.		
Measuring devices:	Measuring devices that only measure distance may be used during the championship.		
Spectator carts:	Spectator carts will be available to rent for \$20 per person. All carts are restricted to the cart path.		
Player Registration:	Players registration will be at Columbia CC on Monday, July 30th from 3:00 p.m. – 5:00 p.m.		
Player lunch:	Lunch will be provided for all players after the final tournament round.		
Hotels:	The Holiday Inn Express in Blythewood is offering a rate of \$85.00 plus tax per night for reservations made by June 9, 2014. Please call the hotel direct at 803-333-0315 and ask for the Twins States rate.		
Junior Teams:	The overall champion will be invited to represent the Carolinas Golf Association in the Mid-Atlantic Junior Girls' Matches at the Clubs at Olde Mill in Laurel Fork, VA on July 26-27, 2014.		
Rankings:	This is a girls' TYGA rankings event that has been assigned a multiplier of 8. This is a girls' SCJGA rankings event that has been assigned a multiplier of 7.		
Parent policy:	Parents are encouraged to follow their child. We do ask that all parents remain on the cart path, unless assisting with the search for a ball.		
Withdraws:	If you cannot compete in this championship, you must withdraw from the event by contacting the CGA office at 910- 673-1000 prior to the first round. If you do not withdraw properly, you are considered a "no show" and may be suspended from CGA events for 1 year.
