ELIGIBILITY

Entry is open to any male amateur golfer who has reached his 13th birthday by May 6, 2015, is a legal resident of North Carolina or South Carolina, is a member in good standing of a club which is a member of the Carolinas Golf Association (CGA) and has an active GHIN® USGA Handicap Index® at a CGA member club. Entries are subject to rejection at any time, including during the event, by the CGA or the host club. The reason for rejection may include unbecoming conduct or cell phone use during a stipulated round. All players must conform to the "USGA Rules of Amateur Status" as specified in the "Rules of Golf"

<u>College Student Eligibility</u>: A college student is considered a resident of their parent(s)/guardian(s) "Legal Residency Criteria" as stated in the CGA Tournament Manual unless said student (a) has no dependency on his/her parents; <u>and</u> (b) lives full time in North Carolina or South Carolina.

For complete residency and eligibility requirements, refer to the <u>CGA</u> <u>Tournament Manual</u> at the CGA website (www.carolinasgolf.org).

Championship field size=88 teams.

ENTRIES (NEW)

All players, including those exempt, must register online at www.carolinasgolf.org. Mail-in applications are no longer accepted for this event. Fax, mail, e-mail, telephone, incomplete, illegible, or entries received before the opening date and after the closing date, are not accepted. Entries are accumulated for the entire open/close window. Exempt teams are accepted at time of entry. The remainder of the field is selected after entries close with the lowest team handicap indexes. Alternates are ranked according to team handicap index.

The CGA is not responsible for errors or delays by any internet service provider. Entries are only accepted between the open and close dates as stated above. Confirmation of acceptance and tournament information is sent to players when their status has been determined. Status may be checked at www.carolinasgolf.org. Teams who "Did Not Show" (DNS) or "No Card" (NC) are suspended from next year's Carolinas Four-Ball Championship.

REFUND POLICY

Entry fee refund policy schedule:

Open Date to Day Prior to Championship Date: Full refund minus \$30.00 administrative fee regardless of reason if entry accepted into championship.

Withdraw on Championship Date; No-Shows: No refund for any reason.

Alternates: Full refund if player does not gain entry into the championship.

RULES

USGA Rules of Golf govern play. Questions will be decided by the on-site Rules Committee whose decision will be final. Notice to Players and local rules are posted at host club and distributed at the starting tee(s). The CGA reserves the right to alter the conditions or schedules as stated, including alteration of the stipulated round(s) at any time during the championship including sectional qualifying. The competition is closed when the championship trophy has been presented. Special requests for starting times or pairings are not granted.

COURSE FEES; GOLF CARTS; CADDIES; SPECTATORS

Stroke Play Qualifying and Match Play Rounds: All championship cart/range fees are paid by the CGA for all players. Players have the option to walk or use a golf cart during championship rounds.

Practice Rounds: Cart rental is mandatory for practice rounds.

 $\it Caddies: Caddies \ are allowed. A player may provide his own caddie. Caddies will not be available at host club.$

Caddie/Spectator Cart Policy: During the play of a hole, either the player or his caddie may ride in a golf cart but not both at the same time. Spectators are not allowed to ride in a player's golf cart at any time. Club owned spectator carts are not allowed except as provided in the CGA Tournament Manual.

FORMAT

Championship format is 36 holes of four-ball stroke play to determine 32 qualifiers for four-ball match play. Matt Crenshaw and Jonathan Jackson are the defending champions and is seeded number one for match play if otherwise eligible.

PRIZES AND MERCHANDISE

The championship team receives merchandise, trophies and names inscribed on the *Hale Van Hoy Trophy*. Stroke play qualifying medalists' names will be inscribed on the *Joe B. McCarley Cup*. Additional prizes are awarded to all match play contestants.

Collegiate players should check with their institution compliance department regarding NCAA regulations relating to accepting prizes or merchandise.

EXEMPTIONS

- 1. Champions of the Carolinas Four-Ball Championship since 2005.
- Teams that qualified for match play at the 2014 Carolinas Four-Ball Championship.
- Matt Crenshaw from Burlington, NC and Jonathan Jackson from Chapel Hill, NC are the defending champions and will be seeded number one for match play if otherwise eligible.
- 4. One exemption for championship host club. Entry must be received by entry closing date.
- 5. Special exemption bestowed by the CGA.

Exempt team members must compete on the same team or with another exempt player.

First and second rounds of four-ball match play (18 holes each round).

Saturday, May 9

Quarterfinal and semifinal rounds of four-ball match play (18 holes each round).

Sunday, May 10

Final match (18 holes).
