ALL COMPETITORS MUST REGISTER ON LINE

ELIGIBILITY

Entry is open to any male amateur golfer who has not reached his 19th birthday by July 30, 2015, who has not started college, is a legal resident of North Carolina or South Carolina, is a member or their parent is a member in good standing of a club which is a member of the Carolinas Golf Association (CGA) and has a current USGA handicap index® at a CGA member club that does not exceed **18.4**. Entries are subject to rejection at any time, including during the event, by the CGA or the host club. The reason for rejection may include unbecoming conduct or cell phone use during a stipulated round. All players must conform to the "USGA Rules of Amateur Status" as specified in the "Rules of Golf". For complete residency and eligibility requirements, refer to the CGA Tournament Manual at the CGA website (www.carolinassgolf.org).

ENTRY FEES (NEW)

Sectional Qualifying Entry Fee: \$50.00

Successful Qualifier Championship Entry Fee: \$50.00 (Fee is charged automatically to the credit card used for sectional qualifying registration).

Exempt Player Entry Fee: \$100.00

ENTRIES AND ONLINE REGISTRATION (NEW)

All players, including those exempt, must register online at www.carolinassgolf.org. Mail-in applications are no longer accepted for this event. Fax, mail, e-mail, telephone, incomplete, illegible, or entries received before the opening date and after the closing date, are not accepted.

Exempt Players: Accepted into the championship proper at time of entry.

Non-exempt Players: Gain entry into the championship proper through sectional qualifying (see "Exemptions from Sectional Qualifying" and "Sectional Qualifying and Alternates" sections).

The CGA is not responsible for errors or delays by any internet service provider. Entries are only accepted between the open and close dates as stated above. Confirmation of acceptance is sent to players when their status is determined. Status may be checked at www.carolinassgolf.org. The appropriate entry fee must be paid by each player at time of registration. **Players who "Did Not Show" (DNS) or "No Card" (NC) are suspended from next year's Carolinas Junior Boys' Championship.**

REFUND POLICY

Entry fee refund policy schedule:

Open Date to Day Prior to Championship: Full refund minus \$30.00 administrative fee if entry accepted into championship.

Withdraw on Championship or Qualifying Date: No refund for any reason. Alternates not gaining entry into the tournament receive a full refund. Refunds are not made for players who are successful in advancing through sectional qualifying but withdraw prior to the championship proper.

RULES

USGA Rules of Golf govern play. Questions will be decided by the on-site Rules Committee whose decision will be final. Notice to Players and local rules are posted at host club and distributed at the starting tee(s). The CGA reserves the right to alter the conditions or schedules as stated, including alteration of the stipulated round(s) at any time during the championship. The competition is closed when the championship trophy has been presented. Special requests for starting times or pairings are not granted.

TEAM MATCHES

The overall champion and runner-up will be invited to represent the CGA in the Carolinas-Virginias Junior Team Matches at Boonesboro CC in Lynchburg, VA on August 8-9, 2015.

AGE DIVISION

Boys will compete in one division. There are no age divisions.

FORMAT

The championship format is 54-holes of stroke play. The field will be reduced to the low 60 and ties after 36 holes.

YARDAGES

Course yardage is approximately 7,000 yards, par 72.

PRIZES

Trophies are awarded to the champion and the top six players.

EXEMPTIONS: QUALIFYING

Players in the following categories are exempt into the championship.

1. Top 40 from the 2014 Carolinas Junior Boys Championship.
 2. Top 8 in the 2015 NC Junior Championship.
 3. Top 8 in the 2015 SCGA Junior Championship.
 4. Top 50 on the SCJGA Junior Boys rankings as of June 8, 2015.
 5. Top 50 on the TYGA NC Junior Boys rankings as of June 8, 2015.
 6. All 2015 US Junior Amateur Championship competitors.
 7. Top 10 in 2015 Jimmy Creed Junior Invitational.
- All exempt players must register on line by the closing date.

Qualifying:

Those not included in the above exempt categories have the opportunity to qualify on July 21 at Camden CC in Camden, SC or on July 21 at Hyland GC in Southern Pines, NC. A minimum of ten spots will be available at each site. The final qualifying numbers will be determined after entries have closed. Players are accepted on a first come, first-serve basis. **Those players who are successful in qualifying on July 21st will be charged \$50.00** (Fee is charged automatically to the credit card used for sectional qualifying registration).
