Tournament Information

Format:	54-holes of stroke play. Each division will be cut to the low half and ties after 36 holes	
Practice round:	A practice round will be available at Prestonwood CC at a rate of \$25 (walking) on August 3, 2015. Contestants must call the golf shop to schedule a practice round starting time. Players may call up to seven days in advance. Please identify yourself as a Dogwood State Junior participant when calling.	
Starting times:	Starting times will be available through the CGA office and/or the carolinasgolf.org web site on July 24 , 2015 . <u>Please do not call before this date</u> .	
Yardages:	Boys' yardage: 7,100 yards, par 72 (74.6/138) Girls' yardage: 5,750 yards. Par 72 (73.3/134)	
Prizes:	Trophies will be awarded to the champion through fifth place in each division.	
Caddies:	Players must walk at all times, but may use a caddy. Caddy must be 18 years of age or younger, no exceptions . Caddies must walk at all times as well.	
Measuring devices:	Devices that measure distance only may be used during this championship.	
Spectator carts:	Spectator carts will be available to rent at a rate of \$25 per cart. Carts must remain on path at all times.	
Method of payments:	Prestonwood CC accepts Master Card and Visa for golf shop, spectator cart rentals, food and beverage purchases.	
Dress code:	No metal or ceramic spikes. Hats/visors must be worn with brim forward and must be removed while indoors. Collared shirts or mock turtlenecks must be worn and tucked in at all times.	
Hotels:	The LaQuinta Inn & Suites in Cary is offering a discounted rate of \$79 (plus tax) per night for reservations made by July 13, 2015. Please call the hotel direct at 919-851-2850 and ask for the Carolinas Golf Association rate.	
Junior Teams:	The boys' champion will be invited to compete in the Carolinas-Virginias junior team matches in 2016 . The girls' champion will be invited to represent the Carolinas in the Mid-Atlantic Challenge in 2016 .	
Rankings:	This is a TYGA ranking's event that has been assigned a multiplier of 7.	
Parent policy:	Parents are encouraged to follow their child. We do ask that all parents remain on the cart path (roughs if no cart paths), unless assisting with the search for a ball.	
Withdraws:	If you cannot compete in this championship, you must withdraw from the event by contacting the CGA office at 910-673-1000 prior to round 1. If you do not withdraw properly, you are considered a "no show" and you will be suspended from CGA events for 1 year.
