### *Tournament Information*

- Host Professional:** Chad Campbell, PGA
- Format:** 18 holes stroke play qualifying followed by match play (6 rounds).  
The field will be cut to the low 63 for match play.  
Defending champion Alex Smalley will be the #1 seed.
- Practice round:** A practice round (\$20 walking rate) will be available at CC of Salisbury on Monday, June 22, 2015. Contestants must call the golf shop to schedule a practice round starting time. Players may call beginning June 9th. Please identify yourself as a North Carolina Junior participant when calling.
- Starting times:** Starting times will be available through the CGA office and/or the carolinagolf.org web site on **June 17, 2015 after 12 noon.**

**Yardages:** Approx. 6,665 yards, par 71 (72.0/130)

- Prizes:** Trophies will be awarded to the champions, runner-up, semi-finalists, quarter-finalists and medalist.
- Caddies:** Players must walk at all times, but may use a caddy.  
Caddy must be 18 years of age or younger, **no exceptions.**  
Caddies must walk at all times as well.  
CC of Salisbury does allow push carts.
- Measuring Devices** Distance measuring devices will be allowed.
- Spectator carts:** Spectator carts will be available to rent at a rate of \$20 per cart. Spectator carts must remain on the cart path at all times.
- Method of payments:** CC of Salisbury accepts **CASH ONLY** for practice round and food and beverages purchases.
- Dress code:** No metal or ceramic spikes.  
Hats/visors must be worn with brim forward and must be removed while indoors.  
Collared shirts or mock turtlenecks must be worn and tucked in at all times.  
Women's fashion shirts without a collar must have sleeves.  
Women's fashion shirts must not rise above the belt line at anytime during the golf swing.  
Shorts must be no more than 5" above the knee.
- Player Registration:** All players are asked register at the CC of Salisbury on Monday, June 22<sup>nd</sup> from 5:00 pm – 7:00 p.m.
- Tournament cookout:** All players and parents are invited to the tournament cookout on Monday, June 22<sup>nd</sup> from 5:00 pm – 7:00 pm at CC of Salisbury.
- Junior Teams:** The champion in the boys' division will be invited to represent the Carolinas in the Virginias-Carolinas Junior Team matches at Boonesboro CC in Lynchburg, VA on August 8-9, 2015.
- Rankings:** This is a TYGA junior rankings event that has been assigned a multiplier of 7.
- Parent policy:** Parents are encouraged to follow their child. We do ask that all parents remain on the cart path (roughs if no cart paths), unless assisting with the search for a ball.
- Withdraws:** If you cannot compete in this championship, you must withdraw from the event by contacting the CGA office at 910-673-1000 prior to round 1. If you do not withdraw properly, you are considered a "no show" and you will be suspended from the 2016 NC Junior.
