18th Parent-Child Championship of the Carolinas Golf Association Pinewild Country Club (Magnolia), Pinehurst, NC Friday, July 24, 2015

Player Information

Site Information: Pinewild Country Club is the championship site hosting the Carolinas Parent-Child Championship and the Super Senior & Open Divisions of the Carolinas Father-Son Championship. Championships will be played on the club's Magnolia course.

Yardage:

Males age 14+ play the White tees (6200 yards)

Females age 14-49 play the Red tees (5100 yards)

13 & Under Boys/Girls and Females age 50+ will play a composite set of tees using the Red and Orange courses. Play the Red tees on Holes #2, 4, 6-9, 11-14, 18 and Orange tees on Holes #1, 3, 5, 10, 15-17 (4800 yards). CGA will place a dedicated tee marker (Black) at these locations for the championship round.

Note that yardage is subject to change.

Tee to play will be denoted on the championship scorecard for each player.

Practice Round: Players are allowed one practice round on July 23rd from 11:00am to 3:00pm based upon availability and must call in advance for a starting time. Players may begin calling the Pinewild golf shop on July 15 for practice round starting times. Mandatory cart/range fee for practice round is \$25.00 per player.

Championship Format: Carolinas Parent-Child format is modified alternate shot where both team members play from each teeing ground, select a ball, then play alternate shot until the ball is holed. Teams are flighted according to team handicap index formula using 2/3 low index plus 1/3 high index.

Tournament Registration: There is no formal registration at Pinewild Country Club. Championship round cart/range fees are paid by the CGA. Please be at your assigned tee at least 5 minutes prior to the start of your round to receive tournament information.

Carts and Caddies: Cart use is mandatory for this championship (No walking!). Caddies are allowed, but must walk. Spectator carts for persons with a bona fide medical condition may be available. Check in with the CGA staff member in charge to request a cart.

Tee Times: Starting times for the championship will be available on Friday, July 17 by 5:00pm. Starting times will begin at 12:30 off #1 and #10 tees. Players may call the Carolinas Golf Association, or check the CGA website (www.carolinanagolf.org) to view starting times and pairings. Late to the tee penalties will be enforced.

Accepted Forms of Payment: Pinewild accepts checks, cash, MasterCard and Visa for golf shop purchases, practice round fees and food purchases.

Policies and Rules: Pinewild is a spikeless facility. Proper golf attire and footwear must be worn (no denim, tee shirts or tank tops; collared shirts are required). Personal coolers are not allowed. Distance measuring devices are permitted during this event. Gift certificates are valid for one year.

Directions: Pinewild has two entrances. One is on Highway 211 about 5 miles west of the traffic circle. The other entrance is on Linden Road about 1 mile west off Highway 5. [MAP](#)
