Format: Junior division: 36-holes of individual stroke play. Players will be flighted after the first round.

Sub junior division: 18-holes of individual stroke play (9 holes each day).

Course: Chapel Hill Country Club, 103 Lancaster Dr. Chapel Hill, NC 27514.

Practice round: A practice round will be available at Chapel Hill CC on Monday, July 30, 2014. Contestants must call the golf shop to

schedule a practice round starting time. Please identify yourself as a Twin States participant when calling. Players

may call for practice round starting times beginning June 16, 2014.

Starting times: Starting times will be available on Sunday, June 24 after 12pm through the carolinasgolf.org web site or by calling

the CGA office.

Caddies: Players must walk at all times, but may use a caddie. Caddie must be 18 years of age or younger, no exceptions.

Caddies must walk at all times. Players may use push carts.

Push carts: Players will be allowed to use push carts at Chapel Hill CC.

Measuring devices: Measuring devices that only measure distance may be used during the championship.

Spectator carts: Spectator carts will be available to rent for \$20 per person. All carts are restricted to the cart path.

Player Registration: Players registration will be at Chapel Hill CC on Monday, June 29th from 3:00 p.m. – 5:00 p.m.

Player lunch: Lunch will be provided for all players after the both rounds. Boxed Lunches for players after first round. Lunch for

players and parents after the second round.

This is a girls' SCJGA rankings event that has been assigned a multiplier of 7.

Parent policy: Parents are encouraged to follow their child. We do ask that all parents remain on the cart path, unless assisting with

the search for a ball.

Withdraws: If you cannot compete in this championship, you must withdraw from the event by contacting the CGA office at 910-

673-1000 prior to the first round. If you do not withdraw properly, you are considered a "no show" and may be

suspended from CGA events for 1 year.
