Tournament Information

Format: 36-hole stroke play

Practice round: Practice rounds were not included in the entry fee. Practice rounds will be available on March 7 – April 1

when space is available. The fee for practice rounds is \$20 (walking) and is open to players and parents.

Please call the Jacksonville CC golf shop to schedule practice round date and time.

Starting times: Starting times will be available on March 26, 2016. Starting times and pairings will be emailed to the

contestants. Saturday's starting times will range from 12:00 pm to approximately 2:00 pm. Sunday's

starting times will range from 8:00 am to approximately 10:00 am.

Yardages: Boys' yardage – 6,600 yards, par 72

Prizes: Trophies will be awarded to the overall champion and the top five places in each division.

NC Junior Champ. The top 10 (and ties) will receive an exemption into the 49th NC Junior Championship at Wilson CC in

Wilson, NC on June 21-24, 2016.

Joe Cheves Jr. The overall champion will receive invitations to the 2016 Joe Cheves Junior Invitational hosted

by Mimosa Hills CC in Morganton, NC.

Caddies: Caddies will not be allowed. Each player must walk and carry their own golf bag. Push carts are allowed.

Spectator carts: Spectator carts will be available to rent at a rate of \$20 per cart. Carts must remain on paths at all times.

Dress code: Hats/visors must be worn with brim forward; males must remove hat/visor while indoors.

Collared shirts or mock turtlenecks must be worn and tucked in at all times.

Hotel: The Comfort Suites in Jacksonville is offering a flat rate of \$75 per night (plus tax) for reservations made by

March 11, 2016. Please call the Comfort Suites directly at 910-346-8900 and ask for the Carolinas Golf

Association rate.

Parents are encouraged to follow their child. We do ask that all parents remain on the cart path (roughs in

no cart paths), unless assisting with the search for a ball.

Withdraws: If you cannot compete and need to withdraw from this tournament, please call CGA at 910-673-1000.

Personal Items: Make sure not to leave any valuable personal items unattended such as jewelry, wallets, etc. even if they

are tucked away inside your golf bag. It is best to leave your valuables locked in your automobile. Neither

the CGA nor the host club will be held responsible for any lost or stolen personal items.

Cell Phones: Except for emergencies, a ruling, viewing tournament leaderboard or use as a distance measuring device,

cell phone use is not allowed on the golf course during championship rounds. Players are permitted to use their smartphone to view the tournament leaderboard as long as the device is on silent, is not used for voice

or texting communications and play is not delayed.

Text Notifications: The Carolinas Golf Association has a new text (SMS) notification feature in the TPP tournament software

that will be used to send text messages to your mobile phone in the event of tournament schedule changes, delays and cancelations. This is a free service provided by the CGA. Note that standard texting

and data rates apply based upon your cell phone plan.
