Tournament Information

- Format:** 54-holes of stroke play. After 36-holes, boys' will be cut to the low 60 and ties and girls' will be cut to the low 18 and ties.
- Practice round:** A practice round will be available at Cabarrus CC at a rate of \$25 (walking) on August 8, 2015. Contestants must call the golf shop to schedule a practice round starting time. Players may call up to seven days in advance. Please identify yourself as a Dogwood State Junior participant when calling.
- Starting times:** Starting times will be available through the CGA office and/or the carolinascga.org web site on **August 3, 2016**. Please do not call before this date.
- Yardages:** Boys' yardage: 6,900 yards, par 72 (blue tees)
Girls' yardage: 5,900 yards, par 72 (white tees)
- Prizes:** Trophies will be awarded to the champion through fifth place in each division.
- Caddies:** Players must walk at all times, but may use a caddy. Caddy must be 18 years of age or younger, **no exceptions**. Caddies must walk at all times as well.
- Push carts:** Cabarrus CC allows push/pull carts.
- Measuring devices:** Devices that measure distance only may be used during this championship.
- Spectator carts:** Spectator carts will be available to rent at a rate of \$25 per cart. Carts must remain on path at all times.
- Method of payments:** Cabarrus CC accepts Master Card and Visa for golf shop, spectator cart rentals, food and beverage purchases.
- Dress code:** No metal or ceramic spikes.
Hats/visors must be worn with brim forward and must be removed while indoors.
Collared shirts or mock turtlenecks must be worn and tucked in at all times.
- Hotels:** The Comfort Inn is offering a discounted rate of \$99 (plus tax) per night for reservations made by July 25, 2016. Please call the hotel direct at 704-979-3800 and ask for the Carolinas Golf Association rate.
- Junior Teams:** The boys' champion will be invited to compete in the Carolinas-Virginias junior team matches in **2017**.
The girls' champion will be invited to represent the Carolinas in the Mid-Atlantic Challenge in **2017**.
- Rankings:** This is a TYGA ranking's event that has been assigned a multiplier of 7.
- Parent policy:** Parents are encouraged to follow their child. We do ask that all parents remain on the cart path (roughs if no cart paths), unless assisting with the search for a ball.
- Withdraws:** If you cannot compete in this championship, you must withdraw from the event by contacting the CGA office at 910-673-1000 prior to round 1. If you do not withdraw properly, you are considered a "no show" and you will be suspended from CGA events for 1 year.
