Starting times:	Starting times will be available through the CGA office and/or the carolinasgolf.org web site on July 12.	
Yardages:	Boys' division: approx. 6,966 yards par 72 (gold tees). Girls' divisions: approx. 5,713 yards par 72 (white tees).	
Prizes:	Trophies will be awarded to the champions, runner-up, semi-finalists and qualifying medalist in each division.	
Caddies:	Players must walk at all times, but may use a caddy. Caddy must be 18 years of age or younger, no exceptions . Caddies must walk at all times as well.	
Push carts:	Players may use a push cart.	
Measuring devices:	Distance measuring devices are allowed during this championship.	
Spectator carts:	Spectator carts will be available to rent at a rate of \$20 per person. Carts must remain on path at all times.	
Method of payments:	Green Valley CC accepts cash, MasterCard and Visa for food and beverage and spectator cart rentals.	
Dress code:	No metal or ceramic spikes. Hats/visors must be worn with brim forward and must be removed while indoors. Collared shirts or mock turtlenecks must be worn and tucked in at all times. Women's fashion shirts without a collar must have sleeves. Women's fashion shirts must not rise above the belt line at anytime during the golf swing. Shorts must be no more than 5" above the knee.	
Junior Teams:	The girls' champion will be invited to represent the CGA in the Mid-Atlantic Girls' Team Matches in 2017. The boys' champion will be invited to represent the CGA in the Carolinas-Virginias junior team matches at River Landing CC in Wallace, NC on August 6-7, 2016.
