- Practice round:** Practice rounds will be available at The Windermere Club any weekday from June 13 – June 27. Contestants must call the golf shop at (803) 786-7888 to schedule a practice round starting time. Please identify yourself as a **Twin States** participant when calling. Players may call for practice round starting times beginning **June 6th**.
- Starting times:** Starting times will be available on **Monday, June 20 after 12pm** on the carolinasgolf.org website or by calling the CGA office.

- Caddies:** Players must walk at all times, but may use a caddie. Caddie must be 18 years of age or younger, **no exceptions**. Caddies must walk at all times. Players may use push carts.
- Push carts:** Players will be allowed to use push carts.
- Measuring devices:** Distance measuring devices may be used during the championship.
- Spectator carts:** Spectator carts will be available to rent for \$15 per person. All carts are restricted to the cart path.
- Player Registration:** Players registration will be at The Windermere Club on Monday, June 27th from 5:30 p.m. – 6:30 p.m.
- Champions Dinner:** The Past Champions Dinner to celebrate the 50th anniversary of the Twin States Girls' Championship will be held on Monday, June 27 at 6:30 p.m. Players must RSVP during online registration.
- Player lunch:** Lunch will be provided for all players after both rounds. Boxed Lunches will be provided for players after first round. Lunch for players and parents will be provided after the final round.
- Hotels:** A block of rooms has been set up at the Fairfield Inn & Suites Marriott Columbia Northeast with a special rate of \$94 for reservations made by June 6, 2016. Please call the hotel directly at 803-760-1700 and ask for the Carolinas Golf Association rate.
- Junior Teams:** The overall champion will be invited to represent the Carolinas Golf Association in the Mid-Atlantic Junior Girls' Matches at Williamsburg Golf Club in Williamsburg, VA on July 30-31, 2016.
- Rankings:** This is a girls' TYGA rankings event that has been assigned a multiplier of 8.
This is a girls' SCJGA rankings event that has been assigned a multiplier of 7.
- Parent policy:** Parents are encouraged to spectate at this event. We do ask that all parents remain on the cart path, unless assisting with the search for a ball.
- Withdraws:** If you cannot compete in this championship, you must withdraw from the event by contacting the CGA office at 910-673-1000 prior to the first round. If you do not withdraw properly, you are considered a "no show" and may be suspended from CGA events for one year.
