ELIGIBILITY

Entry is open to any male amateur golfer who has not reached his 19th birthday by July 27, 2017, who has not started college, is a legal resident of North Carolina or South Carolina, is a member in good standing of a club which is a member of the Carolinas Golf Association (CGA) and has a current USGA handicap index® at a CGA member club that does not exceed 18.4. Entries are subject to rejection at any time, including during the event, by the CGA or the host club. The reason for rejection may include unbecoming conduct or cell phone use during a stipulated round. All players must conform to the "USGA Rules of Amateur Status" as specified in the "Rules of Golf". For complete residency and eligibility requirements, refer to the CGA Tournament Manual at the CGA website (www.carolinasgolf.org).

ENTRY FEES (NEW)

Sectional Qualifying Entry Fee: \$25.00

Successful Qualifier Championship Entry Fee: \$100.00 (Fee is charged automatically to the credit card used for sectional qualifying registration).

Exempt Player Entry Fee: \$125.00

ENTRIES AND ONLINE REGISTRATION

All players, including those exempt, must register online at www.carolinasgolf.org. Mail-in applications are no longer accepted for this event. Fax, mail, e-mail, telephone, incomplete, illegible, or entries received before the opening date and after the closing date, are not accepted.

Exempt Players: Accepted into the championship proper at time of entry. Non-exempt Players: Gain entry into the championship proper through sectional qualifying (see "Exemptions from Sectional Qualifying" and "Sectional Qualifying and Alternates" sections). The Carolinas Junior qualifier at Goldsboro Golf Course in Goldsboro, NC is held in conjunction with the Dogwood Junior qualifier. Those playing in the Carolinas Junior qualifier and Dogwood qualifier must enter both competitions.

The CGA is not responsible for errors or delays by any internet service provider. Entries are only accepted between the open and close dates as stated above. Confirmation of acceptance is sent to players when their status is determined. Status may be checked at www.carolinasgolf.org. The appropriate entry fee must be paid by each player at time of registration. Players who "Did Not Show" (DNS) or "No Card" (NC) are suspended from next year's Carolinas Junior Boys' Championship.

REFUND POLICY

Entry fee refund policy schedule:

Open Date to Day Prior to Qualifier: Full refund minus \$10.00 administrative fee if entry accepted into qualifier.

Open Date to Day Prior to Championship: Full refund minus \$30.00 administrative fee if entry accepted into championship.

Withdraw on Championship or Qualifying Date: No refund for any reason. Alternates not gaining entry into the tournament receive a full refund. Refunds are not made for players who are successful in advancing through sectional qualifying but withdraw prior to the championship proper.

USGA Rules of Golf govern play. Questions will be decided by the on-site Rules Committee whose decision will be final. Notice to Players and local rules are posted at host club and distributed at the starting tee(s). The CGA reserves the right to alter the conditions or schedules as stated, including alteration of the stipulated round(s) at any time during the championship. The competition is closed when the championship trophy has been presented. Special requests for starting times or pairings are not granted.

TEAM MATCHES

The overall champion and runner-up will be invited to represent the CGA in the Carolinas-Virginias Junior Team Matches at Boonesboro Country Club in Lynchburg, VA on August 12-13, 2017.

Trophies are awarded to the champion and the top six players.

AGE DIVISION

There are no age divisions. Boys will compete in one division.

FORMAT

The championship format is 54-holes of stroke play. The field will be reduced to the low 60 and ties after 36 holes.

YARDAGE

Course yardage is approximately 6,986 yards, par 72.

All exempt players must register online by the closing date.

Those not included in the above exempt categories have the opportunity to qualify on July 7 at Goldsboro Golf Course in Goldsboro, NC or on July 11 at Cherokee National Golf Club in Gaffney, SC. A minimum of ten spots will be available at each site. The final qualifying numbers will be determined after entries have closed. Players are accepted into these qualifiers on a first come, first-serve basis. Players who are successful in qualifying for the championship will be charged an additional entry fee (\$100). The additional fee is charged automatically to the credit card used for sectional qualifying registration.
