

# 21st North Carolina Junior Boys 13 and Under Championship of the Carolinas Golf Association

## **ELIGIBILITY**

Entry is open to any male amateur golfer who has not reached his 14<sup>th</sup> birthday by July 11, 2017, is a legal resident of North Carolina and the junior golfer, parent or guardian is a member in good standing of a club which is a member of the Carolinas Golf Association (CGA). Entries are subject to rejection at any time, including during the event, by the CGA or the host club. The reason for rejection may include unbecoming conduct. For complete residency and eligibility requirements, refer to the CGA Tournament Manual at www.carolinasgolf.org.

## **RULES**

USGA Rules of Golf govern play. Local rules are distributed at the starter's table. The CGA reserves the right to alter the conditions or schedules as stated, including alteration of the stipulated round(s) at any time during the championship. Each competitor must walk and carry his own bag (pull carts allowed if club agrees) during the stipulated round, unless the player employs a caddie. In that case, the caddie must be 18 years old or younger and must walk. Dress code: No cut-off shorts or denim, no shorts shorter than four inches above the knees, no tank tops or t-shirts, and all shirts must have either a collar or sleeves. Use of tobacco products by competitors or caddies is prohibited. Note: The use of cellular phones (except in the case of an emergency or a ruling), portable music devices, headphones, laptop computers, PDA's, pagers, beepers, and the like are not allowed during a stipulated round. The competition is closed when the championship trophy has been presented. Special requests for starting times or pairings are not granted.

# FORMAT

The championship is conducted at match play. There is an 18hole stroke-play qualifying round to determine match play flights and seeding. The top 15 from the stroke-play qualifying will qualify for the championship flight. Defending champion Jackson Van Paris of Pinehurst, NC will be seeded #1 for match play. The other players will be in flights of 8 players based on their qualifying score. The championship flight will play 4 rounds of match play. All matches will be 9-hole matches with the championship match being an 18-hole match (no elimination). All other flights will play 3 rounds of 9-hole matches (no elimination). Since there is no elimination, players are encouraged to play all rounds of match play even if they are defeated in an earlier round. If a player fails to withdraw from the event properly, he will be suspended from all CGA / TYGA events for one year.

# **REFUND POLICY**

Entry fee refund policy schedule:

Open Date to Day Prior to Championship: Full refund minus \$30.00 administrative fee if entry accepted into championship. Withdraw on Championship Date: No refund for any reason. Alternates not gaining entry into the tournament receive a full refund.

# FIELD SIZE AND ACCEPTANCE

The field is limited to the first 40 players that apply for the championship.

#### YARDAGES

Approx. 5,520 yards (red/white tees)

#### PRIZES

Trophies are awarded to the champion, runner-up and semifinalists in the championship flight, the winner and runner-up in all other flights, and the stroke play qualifying medalist.

#### **EXEMPTIONS**

The top 4 in the championship flight will receive exemptions into the 2018 North Carolina Junior Championship.

#### ENTRIES

All players must register online at www.carolinasgolf.org. Mail-in applications are no longer accepted for this event. Fax, mail, e-mail, telephone, incomplete, illegible, or entries received before the opening date and after the closing date, are not accepted. The CGA is not responsible for errors or delays by any Internet service provider. Confirmation of acceptance and lodging information is sent to players when their status is determined. Status may be checked at www.carolinasgolf.org. A player whose check is returned for insufficient funds may be disqualified indefinitely from CGA competitions. Players who "Did Not Show" (DNS) or "No Card" (NC) will be suspended from all CGA / TYGA events for one year.

#### CHAMPIONSHIP SCHEDULE

Monday, July 10 AM - 18-hole stroke play qualifier PM – Round 1 Match Play (9-hole matches) Tuesday, July 11 AM – Round 2 Match Play (9-hole matches) AM - Round 3 Match Play (9-hole matches) PM – Round 4 Match Play (Championship match=18-holes, all others=9-holes) Awards presentation after completion of each flight's final match.
