Format: 54-holes of stroke play. After 36-holes, field will be cut to the low 60 and ties.

Practice round: A practice round will be available at Cabarrus CC at a rate of \$25 (walking) on July 24, 2017. Contestants

must call the golf shop to schedule a practice round starting time. Players may call up to seven days in

advance. Please identify yourself as a Carolinas Junior participant when calling.

Starting times: Starting times will be available through the CGA office and/or the carolinasgolf.org web site on July 17,

2017.

Yardages: Boys' yardage: 6,900 yards, par 72 (blue tees)

Prizes: Trophies will be awarded to the champion through tenth place.

Caddies: Players must walk at all times, but may use a caddy. Caddy must be 18 years of age or younger, no

exceptions. Caddies must walk at all times as well.

Push carts: Cabarrus CC allows push/pull carts.

Measuring devices: Devices that measure distance may be used during this championship.

Spectator carts: Spectator carts will be available to rent at a rate of \$25 per cart. Carts must remain on path at all times.

Method of payments: Cabarrus CC accepts Master Card and Visa for golf shop, spectator cart rentals, food and beverage

purchases.

Dress code: No metal or ceramic spikes.

Hats/visors must be worn with brim forward and must be removed while indoors. Collared shirts or mock turtlenecks must be worn and tucked in at all times.

Hotels: The Comfort Inn is offering a discounted rate of \$109 (plus tax) per night for reservations made by July 10,

2017. Please call the hotel direct at 704-979-3800 and ask for the Carolinas Golf Association rate.

Junior Teams: The boys' champion will be invited to compete in the Carolinas-Virginias Junior Team Matches at

Boonsboro CC in Lynchburg, VA on August 12-13, 2017.

Rankings: This is a SCJGA and TYGA ranking's event that has been assigned a multiplier of 8.

Parent policy: Parents are encouraged to follow their child. We do ask that all parents remain on the cart path (roughs if

no cart paths), unless assisting with the search for a ball.

Withdraws: If you cannot compete in this championship, you must withdraw from the event by contacting the CGA

office at 910-673-1000 prior to round 1. If you do not withdraw properly, you are considered a "no show"

and you will be suspended from CGA events for 1 year.
