Format: 18 holes stroke play qualifying followed by match play (6 rounds).

The field will be cut to the low 64 for match play.

Practice round: A practice round (\$20 walking rate) will be available at Colonial CC from June 21st through June 26th.

Contestants must call the golf shop to schedule a practice round starting time. Players may call beginning

June 7th. Please identify yourself as a North Carolina Junior participant when calling.

Starting times: Starting times will be available through the CGA office and/or the carolinasgolf.org web site on June 15, 2017

after 12 noon.

Yardages: Blue tees - approx. 6,809 yards, par 71 (72.3/123)

Caddy must be 18 years of age or younger, no exceptions.

Caddies must walk at all times as well. Colonial CC does allow push carts.

Measuring Devices Distance measuring devices will be allowed.

Spectator carts: Spectator carts will be available to rent at a rate of \$20 per cart. Spectator carts must remain on the cart path

at all times.

Method of payments: Colonial CC accepts cash, Master Card or Visa for practice round and food and beverages purchases.

Player Registration: All players are asked register at the Colonial CC on Monday, June 26^h from 5:00 pm – 7:00 p.m.

Tournament cookout: All players and parents are invited to the tournament cookout on Monday, June 26th from 5:00 pm - 7:00 pm

at Colonial CC.

Junior Teams: The champion in the boys' division will be invited to represent the Carolinas in the Virginias-Carolinas Junior

Team matches at Boonsboro CC in Lynchburg, VA on August 12-13, 2017..

Rankings: This is a TYGA junior rankings event that has been assigned a multiplier of 7.

Parent policy: Parents are encouraged to follow their child. We do ask that all parents remain on the cart path (roughs if no

cart paths), unless assisting with the search for a ball.

Withdraws: If you cannot compete in this championship, you must withdraw from the event by contacting the CGA office at

be suspended from the 2018 NC Junior.
