- Format:** 18-hole stroke play
- Qualifying spots:** TBD
- Championship entry fee:** Those players who are successful in qualifying will be charged \$75.00.
(Fee is charged automatically to the credit card used for sectional qualifying registration).
- Practice round:** A practice round will be available at Statesville CC on June 6 – June 13, 2017 at a rate of \$20 (walking). Contestants must call the golf shop to schedule a practice round starting time. Please identify yourself as a North Carolina Junior qualifier when calling.
- Starting times:** Starting times will be available through the CGA office and/or the carolinagolf.org web site on **June 7th** .
- Yardages:** 6,569 yards, par 72 (Gold tees except Green tees on #3 and #7)
- Prizes:** Medalist medallion will be awarded to low score for the qualifying.
- Qualifying Site:** Players are allowed to change qualifying sites until the close of entries, but not after the close of entries for any reason.
- Caddies:** Players must walk at all times, but may use a caddy. Caddy must be 18 years of age or younger, **no exceptions**. Caddies must walk at all times as well.
- Push carts:** Statesville CC does allow the use of push carts.
- Measuring devices:** Measuring devices that measure distance only may be used during the championship.
- Spectator carts:** Spectator carts will be available to rent at a rate of \$20 per cart. Carts must remain on paths at all times.
- Dress code:** Hats/visors must be worn with brim forward; males must remove hat/visor while indoors.
Collared shirts or mock turtlenecks must be worn and tucked in at all times.
Shorts must be no more than 5" above the knee.
- Parent policy:** Parents are encouraged to follow their child. We do ask that all parents remain on the cart path (roughs in no cart paths), unless assisting with the search for a ball.
- Withdraws:** If you cannot compete in this qualifier, you must withdraw from the event by contacting the CGA office at 910-673-1000 prior to round 1. If you do not withdraw properly, you are considered a "no show" and you may be suspended from CGA all events for 1 year.
