Format: 18-hole stroke play

Qualifying spots: TBD

Championship entry fee: Those players who are successful in qualifying will be charged \$75.00.

(Fee is charged automatically to the credit card used for sectional qualifying registration).

Practice round: A practice round will be available at Wedgewood on June 1-9, 2017 at a rate of \$20 (walking). Contestants

must call the golf shop to schedule a practice round starting time. Please identify yourself as a North

Carolina Junior qualifier when calling.

Starting times: Starting times will be available through the CGA office and/or the carolinasgolf.org web site on **June 3rd.**

Yardages: Black tees – 6,322 yards, par 72, 69.8/122

Prizes: Medalist medallion will be awarded to low score for the qualifying.

Qualifying Site: Players are allowed to change qualifying sites until the close of entries, but not after the close of entries for

any reason.

Caddies: Players must walk at all times, but may use a caddy. Caddy must be 18 years of age or younger, no

exceptions. Caddies must walk at all times as well.

Push carts: Wedgewood GC does allow the use of push carts.

Measuring devices: Measuring devices may be used during the championship.

Spectator carts: Spectator carts will be available to rent at a rate of \$20 per cart. Carts must remain on paths at all times.

Dress code: Hats/visors must be worn with brim forward; males must remove hat/visor while indoors.

Collared shirts or mock turtlenecks must be worn and tucked in at all times.

Shorts must be no more than 5" above the knee.

Parent policy: Parents are encouraged to follow their child. We do ask that all parents remain on the cart path (roughs in

no cart paths), unless assisting with the search for a ball.

Withdraws: If you cannot compete in this qualifier, you must withdraw from the event by contacting the CGA office at

910-673-1000 prior to round 1. If you do not withdraw properly, you are considered a "no show" and you

may be suspended from CGA all events for 1 year.
