

70th Carolinas Junior Boys' Championship

ELIGIBILITY

Entry is open to any male amateur golfer who has not reached his 19th birthday by July 25, 2019, who has not started college, is a legal resident of North Carolina or South Carolina, is a member or their parent is a member in good standing of a club which is a member of the Carolinas Golf Association (CGA) and has a current USGA handicap index® at a CGA member club that does not exceed **18.4**. Entries are subject to rejection at any time, including during the event, by the CGA or the host club. The reason for rejection may include unbecoming conduct or cell phone use during a stipulated round. All players must conform to the "USGA Rules of Amateur Status" as specified in the "Rules of Golf". For complete residency and eligibility requirements, refer to the CGA Tournament Manual at the CGA website (www.carolinasgolf.org).

ENTRY FEES (NEW)

Sectional Qualifier Entry Fee: \$50.00

Successful Qualifier Championship Entry Fee: \$125.00 (Fee is charged automatically to the credit card used for sectional qualifying registration).

Exempt Player Entry Fee: \$150.00

ENTRIES AND ONLINE REGISTRATION- May 20-June 19

All players, including those exempt, must register online at www.carolinasgolf.org. Mail-in applications are no longer accepted for this event. Fax, mail, e-mail, telephone, incomplete, illegible, or entries received before the opening date and after the closing date, are not accepted.

Exempt Players: Accepted into the championship proper at time of entry.

Non-exempt Players: Gain entry into the championship proper through sectional qualifying (see "Exemptions from Sectional Qualifying" and "Sectional Qualifying and Alternates" sections).

The CGA is not responsible for errors or delays by any internet service provider. Entries are only accepted between the open and close dates as stated above. Confirmation of acceptance is sent to players when their status is determined. Status may be checked at www.carolinasgolf.org. The appropriate entry fee must be paid by each player at time of registration. **Players who "Did Not Show" (DNS) or "No Card" (NC) are suspended from next year's Carolinas Junior Boys' Championship.**

REFUND POLICY

Entry fee refund policy schedule:

Open Date to Day Prior to Qualifier: Full refund minus \$30.00 administrative fee if entry accepted into qualifier.

Open Date to Day Prior to Championship: Full refund minus \$30.00 administrative fee if entry accepted into championship.

Withdraw on Championship or Qualifying Date: No refund for any reason. Alternates not gaining entry into the tournament receive a full refund. Refunds are not made for players who are successful in advancing through sectional qualifying but withdraw prior to the championship proper.

RULES

USGA Rules of Golf govern play. Questions will be decided by the on-site Rules Committee whose decision will be final. Notice to Players and local rules are posted at host club and distributed at the starting tee(s). The CGA reserves the right to alter the conditions or schedules as stated, including alteration of the stipulated round(s) at any time during the championship. The competition is closed when the championship trophy has been presented. Special requests for starting times or pairings are not granted.

TEAM MATCHES

The overall champion and runner-up will be invited to represent the CGA in the Virginias-Carolinas Junior Team Matches at Boonesboro CC in Lynchburg, VA on August 10-11, 2019.

PRIZES

Trophies are awarded to the champion and the top six players.

AGE DIVISION

There are no age divisions. Boys will compete in one division.

FORMAT

The championship format is 54-holes of stroke play. The field will be reduced to the low 70 and ties after 36 holes.

YARDAGE

Course yardage is approximately 6,942 yards, par 72.

EXEMPTIONS; QUALIFYING

Players in the following categories are exempt into the championship

1. Players who made cut in 2018 Carolinas Junior Boys' Championship
2. Top 8 in the 2019 NC Junior Boys' Championship
3. Top 8 in the 2019 SCGA Junior Boys' Championship
4. Top 50 on the SCJGA Junior Boys' rankings as of May 6, 2019
5. Top 50 on the TYGA NC Junior Boys' rankings as of May 6, 2019
6. All 2019 US Junior Amateur Championship competitors
7. Top 10 in 2019 Jimmy Anderson Junior Boys' Invitational
8. Top 10 in 2019 Jimmy Creed Junior Boys' Invitational
9. Top 5 in 2019 TYGA Archdale-Trinity Junior Open
10. Top 5 in 2019 SCJGA Caddie Classic

All exempt players must register online by the closing date.

Qualifying:

Those not included in the above exempt categories have the opportunity to qualify at the below qualifiers. Players may register for one of the sectional qualifiers, but may also register for the second chance qualifier on July 22nd. A minimum of 5 spots will be available at the sectional sites. There will be only 3 spots available at the second chance qualifier. The final sectional qualifying numbers will be determined after entries have closed. Players are accepted into these qualifiers on a first come, first-serve basis. **Players who are successful in qualifying for the championship will be charged an additional entry fee (\$125).** The additional fee is charged *automatically* to the credit card used for sectional qualifying registration.
