## REGISTRATION

Entries Open on May 4, 2023 at 8:00 pm

Entries Close on June 8, 2023 at 11:59 pm

## ENTRY FEES

\$165.00 for championship

\$55.00 for qualifiers. **Players who are successful in qualifying for the championship will be charged an additional entry fee (\$165).** Unless otherwise note, the additional fee is charged *automatically* to the credit card used for sectional qualifying registration.

## ELIGIBILITY

Entry is open to any male amateur golfer who has not reached his 19<sup>th</sup> birthday as of the date of the final round of the championship, who has not started college, maintains a residence in North or South Carolina, is a member in good standing of a club which is a member of the Carolinas Golf Association (CGA) and has a current GHIN® Number at a CGA member club with an index that does not exceed **15.0**. Entries are subject to rejection at any time, including during the event, by the CGA or the host club. The reason for rejection may include unbecoming conduct or cell phone use during a stipulated round. All players must conform to the "USGA Rules of Amateur Status" as specified in "The Rules of Golf". ## ENTRIES AND ONLINE REGISTRATION (NEW)

All players, including those exempt, must register online at [www.carolinascgolf.org](http://www.carolinascgolf.org). Mail-in applications are no longer accepted for this event. **Exempt Players:** Accepted into the championship proper at time of entry. **Non-exempt Players:** Gain entry into the championship proper through sectional qualifying (see "Exemptions" and "Sectional Qualifying" sections). The CGA is not responsible for errors or delays by any internet service provider. Entries are only accepted between the open and close dates as stated above. Confirmation of acceptance is sent to players when their status is determined. Status may be checked at [www.carolinascgolf.org](http://www.carolinascgolf.org). The appropriate entry fee must be paid by each player at time of registration.

## REFUND POLICY

Entry fee refund policy schedule:

**Open Date to Two Days Prior to Championship or Qualifying Date:** Full refund minus \$30.00 administrative fee regardless of reason if entry accepted into championship or sectional qualifier.

**Withdraw on day before or Championship or Qualifying Date; No-Shows:** No refund for any reason.

## RULES

USGA Rules of Golf govern play. Questions will be decided by the on-site Rules Committee whose decision will be final. Notice to Players and local rules are posted at host club and distributed at the starting tee(s). The CGA reserves the right to alter the conditions or schedules as stated, including alteration of the stipulated round(s) at any time during the championship. The competition is closed when the championship trophy has been presented. Special requests for starting times or pairings are not granted.

## AUTOMOTIVE TRANSPORTATION; CADDIES; SPECTATORS

**Caddies:** Must be 18 or under.

**Transportation:** Players must walk at all times.

**Spectators:** Spectators are welcome at CGA junior championships, however, the availability of carts is left at the discretion of the host club.

## PRIZES

Trophies are awarded to the champion and the top six players.

## FORMAT

The championship format is 54-holes of stroke play. The field will be reduced to the low 60 and ties after 36 holes.

## AGE DIVISIONS

**Boys will compete in one division.** There are no age divisions.

## YARDAGE

Course yardage is approximately 7,082 yards, par 72 (Gold tees)

## TEAM MATCHES

The overall champion will be invited to represent the CGA in the Virginia-Carolin's Junior Team Matches at TBD.
