



# 56TH N.C. JUNIOR BOYS' CHAMPIONSHIP

### REGISTRATION

Entries open on May 4, 2023 at 8:00 pm  
Entries close on June 8, 2023 at 11:59 pm

### ENTRY FEES

\$165.00 for championship  
\$55.00 for qualifiers. **Those players who are successful in qualifying will be charged \$165.00** (fee is charged to the credit card used for sectional qualifying registration).

### ELIGIBILITY

Entry is open to any male amateur golfer who has not reached his 19<sup>th</sup> birthday as of June 23, 2023, who has not started college, is a legal resident of North Carolina, is a member in good standing of a club which is a member of the Carolinas Golf Association (CGA) and has a current GHIN® Number at a CGA member club with an index that does not exceed **15.0**. Entries are subject to rejection at any time, including during the event, by the CGA or the host club. The reason for rejection may include unbecoming conduct or cell phone use during a stipulated round. All players must conform to the "USGA Rules of Amateur Status" as specified in "The Rules of Golf". ### ENTRIES AND ONLINE REGISTRATION (NEW)

All players, including those exempt, must register online at [www.carolinagolf.org](http://www.carolinagolf.org). Mail-in applications are no longer accepted for this event.

**Exempt Players:** Accepted into the championship proper at time of entry.

**Non-exempt Players:** Gain entry into the championship proper through sectional qualifying (see "Exemptions from Sectional Qualifying" and "Sectional Qualifying and Alternates" sections).

The CGA is not responsible for errors or delays by any internet service provider. Entries are only accepted between the open and close dates as stated above. Confirmation of acceptance is sent to players when their status is determined. Status may be checked at [www.carolinagolf.org](http://www.carolinagolf.org). The appropriate entry fee must be paid by each player at time of registration.

### REFUND POLICY

Entry fee refund policy schedule:

**Open Date to Two Days Prior to Championship or Qualifying Date:** Full refund minus \$30.00 administrative fee regardless of reason if entry accepted into championship or sectional qualifier.

**Withdrawal on day before or Championship or Qualifying Date; No-Shows:** No refund for any reason.

**Alternates:** Full refund if player does not gain entry into a qualifying site.

Any withdrawal the day prior to or the day of the tournament will not receive a refund. All other withdrawals are subject to a \$30 admin fee.

### RULES

USGA Rules of Golf govern play. Questions will be decided by the on-site Rules Committee whose decision will be final. Notice to Players and local rules are posted at host club and distributed at the starting tee(s). The CGA reserves the right to alter the conditions or schedules as stated, including alteration of the stipulated round(s) at any time during the championship. The competition is closed when the championship trophy has been presented. Special requests for starting times or pairings are not granted.

### FORMAT

The championship format is match play with an 18-hole stroke play qualifier (Tuesday, June 20) to determine the seeding for match play. The top 64 boys from the stroke play qualifier will advance to match play. Once a player loses a match they are eliminated from the tournament.

### YARDAGES

Boys will compete at approximately 7,120 yards (Purple Tees)

### AUTOMOTIVE TRANSPORTATION; CADDIES; SPECTATORS

**Transportation:** Players must walk at all times but may use a pull/push cart.

**Caddies:** Caddies must be 18 or Under

**Spectators:** Spectators are welcome at CGA championships. Spectator carts will be available for rent for \$25 per day. Carts must remain on the cart path and out of the way of play.

### AGE DIVISIONS

**There are no age divisions.** Boys will compete in one division.

### PRIZES

Trophies are awarded to the champion, runner-up, semifinalists, quarterfinalists, and the stroke play qualifying medalist.

### CHAMPIONSHIP FIELD SIZE

150 players

Overall results (not age divisions) are used to determine the exemptions from individual tournaments. *Being invited does not guarantee acceptance. Registration opens to invited players at 8:00 pm on May 4, 2023. All exempt players must register by the closing date.*

### SECTIONAL QUALIFYING

Those not included in the above categories have the opportunity to qualify on:

**June 13<sup>th</sup> at Duplin Country Club, Kenansville, NC**  
**June 14<sup>th</sup> at The Valley Golf Course, Burlington, NC**

A minimum of five spots will be available at each site. The final qualifying numbers will be determined after entries have closed. **Those players who are successful in qualifying will be charged championship entry fee of \$165.00** (fee is charged automatically to the credit card used for sectional qualifying registration).
