21ST CAROLINAS MIXED TEAM CHAMPIONSHIP

ELIGIBILITY

Entry is open to any team comprised of a male amateur and a female amateur golfer who have reached their 13th birthdays by August 15, 2026, are legal residents of North Carolina or South Carolina, are members in good standing of a club that is a member of the Carolinas Golf Association (CGA), and has an active USGA Handicap Index® at a CGA member club. Entries are subject to rejection at any time, including during the event, by the CGA or the host club. The reason for rejection may include unbecoming conduct as defined by the [CGA Code of Conduct Policy](#) or cell phone use during a round. All players must conform to the “USGA Rules of Amateur Status” as specified in the “Rules of Golf”. For complete residency and eligibility requirements, refer to the [CGA Tournament Manual](#).

Championship Field Size: 52 teams

ENTRY WINDOW AND ONLINE REGISTRATION

All players, including those exempt, must register online at www.carolinascgolf.org. Mail-in applications are not accepted for this event. Fax, mail, e-mail, telephone, incomplete, illegible, or entries received before the opening date and after the closing date, are not accepted.

Entry Fee: \$475 (includes both team members)

Exempt entries open on June 8, 2026.

Exempt players should register by June 21 to ensure acceptance.

Entries open for ALL PLAYERS on June 22, 2026.

Entries will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis after they open for all players on June 22, 2026.

Entries close on August 5, 2026.

The CGA is not responsible for errors or delays by any internet service provider. Entries are only accepted between the open and close dates as stated above. Confirmation of acceptance is sent to players when their status is determined. The appropriate entry fee must be paid at time of registration. **Players who "Did Not Show" (DNS) or "No Card" (NC) are suspended from next year's Carolinas Mixed Team Championship.**

WAITLIST ORDER

The waitlist will be filled based on the order the entry was received while entries are open. Once entries close and pairings are created, the waitlist will be filled based on the division of the team to withdraw.

LATE REGISTRATION

Late entries are not guaranteed entry into a tournament.

After the close of entries, a player/team may contact the CGA at tournaments@carolinascgolf.org or contact the official in charge (listed on the tournament website) to request a late entry. Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the CGA and only if a spot is available in the field.

Accepted late entries will be charged a \$30 late fee in addition to the entry fee of the tournament. The late fee is non-refundable, regardless of participation in the tournament

EXEMPTIONS

Players in the following categories are exempt if otherwise eligible.

Exempt team members must compete on the same team or with another exempt player.

1. Champions of the Carolinas Mixed Team Championship Division since 2021.
2. Winners of each division in the 2025 Carolinas Mixed Team Championship.
3. One exemption for the championship host club.

21ST CAROLINAS MIXED TEAM CHAMPIONSHIP

FORMAT

The championship format is 36 holes using a mixed format of four-ball stroke play and modified alternate shot. Gross scores only.

Teams may choose to compete in any division in which they are eligible: Championship Division; Tournament Division (shorter course, no age requirements); Senior Division (male age 55+, female age 50+); or Super Senior Division (male age 65+, female age 65+).

All divisions will be pre-flighted based on the low player index of the side (dependent on the number of entries).

PRIZES

Only teams competing in the Championship Division are eligible to win the overall championship. Overall champions and low scorers in each division will receive trophies. Merchandise will be awarded to low scorers in each flight. Any tie for the overall championship and/or division winners is decided by an on-course playoff. All other ties for merchandise will be decided by a scorecard playoff.

CHAMPIONSHIP SCHEDULE

Friday, August 14: Tee times available for practice rounds.

Saturday, August 15: First round. 18 holes of four-ball stroke play.

Sunday, August 16: Final Round. 18 holes of modified alternate shot stroke play. The awards ceremony immediately following play.

RULES

USGA Rules of Golf govern play. Questions will be decided by the on-site Rules Committee, whose decision will be final. Notice to Players will be distributed at the starting tee(s). The CGA reserves the right to alter the conditions or schedules as stated, including alteration of the round(s) at any time during the championship. The competition is closed when the championship trophy has been presented. Special requests for starting times or pairings are not granted.

INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY

Every effort will be made to complete all scheduled rounds. There are no refunds if the tournament is shortened due to weather. If the entire tournament is cancelled, a full refund will be issued to all players.

REFUND POLICY

Entry fee refund policy schedule:

Open Date – Tuesday, August 11 at 11:59 p.m.: Full refund minus \$30.00 administrative fee refunded regardless of reason if entry is accepted into the championship.

Withdraw Wednesday, August 12 or later: No refund for any reason.

Waitlist: Full refund if player does not gain entry into the championship.

CART/RANGE FEES; GOLF CARTS; CADDIES; SPECTATORS

Practice Rounds: Practice round fees are as listed, regardless of cart rental.

Championship Rounds: Daily cart and range fees are included in the entry fee.

Competitors have the option to either walk or use a golf cart during championship rounds.

Caddies: Caddies are prohibited from all CGA championships.

Spectator Cart Policy: Spectators are not allowed to ride in a player's golf cart at any time. Spectator carts will not be available at the championship.
