## **ELIGIBILITY**

Entry is open to any female amateur golfer who has reached her 50<sup>th</sup> birthday (Senior Championship) or who has reached her 65<sup>th</sup> birthday (Super Senior Championship) by May 11th 2026, is a legal resident of North Carolina, is a member in good standing of a club which is a member of the Carolinas Golf Association (CGA) and has an active USGA Handicap Index® at a CGA member club. Entries are subject to rejection at any time, including during the event, by the CGA or the host club. The reason for rejection may include unbecoming conduct as defined by the [CGA Code of Conduct Policy](#) or cell phone use during a round. All players must conform to the "USGA Rules of Amateur Status" as specified in the "Rules of Golf". For complete residency and eligibility requirements, refer to the [CGA Tournament Manual](#).

**Championship Field Size:** 64 players

## **ENTRY WINDOW AND ONLINE REGISTRATION**

**All players, including those exempt, must register online at [www.carolinasgolf.org](http://www.carolinasgolf.org). Mail-in applications are not accepted for this event.** Fax, mail, e-mail, telephone, incomplete, illegible, or entries received before the opening date and after the closing date, are not accepted.

**Entry Fee:** \$215

**Exempt entries open on March 2, 2026.**

Exempt players should register by March 15 to ensure acceptance.

**Entries open for ALL PLAYERS on March 16, 2026.**

Entries will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis after they open for all players on March 16, 2026.

**Entries close on April 30, 2026.**

The CGA is not responsible for errors or delays by any internet service provider. Entries are only accepted between the open and close dates as stated above. Confirmation of acceptance is sent to players when their status is determined. The appropriate entry fee must be paid at time of registration. **Players who "Did Not Show" (DNS) or "No Card" (NC) are suspended from next year's North Carolina Senior and Super Senior Women's Amateur Championships.**

## **LATE REGISTRATION**

**Late entries are not guaranteed entry into a tournament.**

After the close of entries, a player/team may contact the CGA at [tournaments@carolinasgolf.org](mailto:tournaments@carolinasgolf.org) or contact the official in charge (listed on the tournament website) to request a late entry. Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the CGA and only if a spot is available in the field.

Accepted late entries will be charged a \$30 late fee in addition to the entry fee of the tournament. The late fee is non-refundable, regardless of participation in the tournament

## **EXEMPTIONS**

Players in the following categories are exempt to signup early if otherwise eligible.

1. Champions of the North Carolina Senior Women's Amateur Championship since 2016.
2. Champions of the Carolinas Senior Women's Amateur Championship since 2016.
3. Champions of the North Carolina Super Senior Women's Amateur Championship since 2023.
4. Champions of the Carolinas Super Senior Women's Amateur Championship since 2023.
5. Players who finished in the Top 10 of the 2025 North Carolina Senior Women's Amateur Championship.
6. Players who finished in the Top 10 of the 2025 North Carolina Super Senior Women's Amateur Championship.
7. Players who finished in the Top 10 of the 2025 Carolinas Senior Women's Amateur Championship.
8. Players who finished in the Top 10 of the 2025 Carolinas Super Senior Women's Amateur Championship.
9. Senior playing members of the 2025 Carolinas Team.

10. Players ranked in the Top 25 of the Carolinas Senior Women's Amateur Rankings as of March 1, 2026.
11. USGA individual champions since 2021.
12. 2025 USGA Championship qualifiers.
13. One exemption for the championship host club.

## **FORMAT**

Both championships are conducted at 36 holes of individual stroke play (no cut). Players are flighted before the first round by handicap index as of May 1, 2026. The overall champion can come from any flight within the championship.

Players competing in the NC Senior Women's Amateur Championship must be **50** years of age or older.

Players competing in the NC Super Senior Women's Amateur Championship must be **65** years of age or older.

## **YARDAGE**

Senior Championship Yardage: 5400 yards (approximately)

Super Senior Championship Yardage: 4900 yards (approximately)

## **PRIZES**

Prizes and merchandise are awarded to the overall champions. Merchandise is awarded to gross scores and one net place in each flight in each championship. Gross winners are ineligible for a net prize and vice versa. A tie for the overall champion is decided by an on-course playoff. All other ties are broken by scorecard playoff.

## **VIRGINIAS-CAROLINAS WOMEN'S TEAM MATCHES EXEMPTION**

The North Carolina Senior Women's Amateur Champion will automatically qualify for the 2027 Carolinas Team that will compete in the Virginias-Carolinas Women's Team Matches (site and date TBD).

## **CHAMPIONSHIP SCHEDULE**

### **Sunday, May 10**

Tee times available for practice.

### **Monday, May 11**

First round. 18 holes of stroke play.

### **Tuesday, May 12**

Final Round. 18 holes of stroke play.

Lunch provided for players. Awards ceremony immediately following play.

## **RULES**

USGA Rules of Golf govern play. Questions will be decided by the on-site Rules Committee whose decision will be final. Notice to Players and local rules are distributed at the starting tee(s). The CGA reserves the right to alter the conditions or schedules as stated, including alteration of the round(s) at any time during the championship. The competition is closed when the championship trophy has been presented. Special requests for starting times or pairings are not granted.

## **INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICY**

Every effort will be made to complete all scheduled rounds. There are no refunds if the tournament is shortened due to weather. If the entire tournament is cancelled, a full refund will be issued to all players.

## **REFUND POLICY**

Entry fee refund policy schedule:

**Open Date – Thursday, May 7 at 11:59 p.m.:** Full refund minus \$30 administrative fee refunded regardless of reason if entry accepted into championship.

**Withdraw Friday, May 8 or later:** No refund for any reason.

**Waitlist:** Full refund if player does not gain entry into championship.

## **CART/RANGE FEES; GOLF CARTS; CADDIES; SPECTATORS**

**Practice Rounds:** Practice round fees are as listed, regardless of cart rental.

**Championship Rounds:** Daily cart and range fees are included in the entry fee.

Competitors have the option to either walk or use a golf cart during championship rounds.

**Caddies:** Caddies are prohibited from all CGA championships.

**Spectator Cart Policy:** Spectators are not allowed to ride in a player's golf cart at any time. Spectator carts will not be allowed at CGA women's championships.
